**Acquisition.** All the documents in this collection were provided to the Johannesburg College of Education (JCE) by its parent body, the Transvaal Education department (TED). When JCE merged with the University of the Witwatersrand (Wits) in 2002 the documents became the property of Wits.

**Copyright.** No copyright restrictions.

**Historical note on the TED.** The Transvaal Education Department was first formed in 1876 as a unit within the independent Zuid-Afrikaansche Republiek (ZAR). The Department endured through all subsequent annexations, wars and vicissitudes until the end of white minority rule in 1994. In December 1994, the Transvaal province was abolished and split into four new provinces.

## SERIES D. T.E.D ANNUAL REPORTS, 1906-1993

**The first report** in this collection is that for the year ended 30 June 1906. It was the first report of the central British colonial authority after the Anglo-Boer war of 1899 to 1902. The colonial secretary, P. Duncan, describes the utter destitution and displacement of the people and the severe dearth of school buildings. However, the Government Notice 860 of 1903 had started the process of rebuilding. It stipulated that parents of school-age children must elect committees from amongst themselves to advise the government on their children's schooling needs. In 1905, based on the advice from the parents, the Colony duly constituted regional School Boards. In 1906, the British granted internal self-government to the Transvaal Colony. The colonial secretary accordingly had to hand over the responsibility for education to the elected houses of parliament of the Colony. In handing over, he presented the first report after the War. The name or post of the official who wrote the report is not given, but the statement of departmental responsibility reads 'Transvaal Education Department'. It remained so until the last report in this collection, 1993.

**The second report** in this collection is for the twelve months ending 30 June 1908. There was no report for the previous year, as 1907 was a year of elections, reorganization, and the drafting and passing of the Education Act. The report was made by the Director of Education, and was 'presented to both Houses of Parliament, by command of His Excellency the Governor'.

**The third report** in this collection is for the twelve months ending 30 June 1909. It too was made by the Director of Education, and was also 'presented to both Houses of Parliament, by command of His Excellency the Governor'.

**The fourth report.** In 1910 the four colonies in South Africa were amalgamated into the Union of South Africa. The Transvaal was therefore no longer a colony, but a province of the larger colony, the Union. In 1910 the Director therefore offers the report for the twelve months ending 30 June 1910 to 'Hon. the Administrator, Transvaal', and so it remained till 1993.

1906 and 1908. English only.

1909 to 1921. Available separately in English and Dutch (Hollands).

1922 to 1980. Available separately in English and Afrikaans.

1980 to 1993. English and Afrikaans versions are printed head-to-tail in the same volume.

The vast majority of reports in this collection are in English, but one Dutch and thirty-six Afrikaans reports are included. All of these, except 1921 and 1954, duplicate the English reports. This collection does not have English reports for 1921 and 1954.

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**Acquisition.** All the documents in this collection were provided to the Johannesburg College of Education (JCE) by the Department of Education (DoE). When JCE merged with the University of the Witwatersrand (Wits) in 2002 the documents became the property of Wits.

**Copyright.** No copyright restrictions.

**Historical note on the DoE.** By the end of white minority rule in 1994 South Africa and its ten independent homelands had eighteen departments of education. Four of these were national, four more were provincial and ten were homeland departments. After black majority rule came about in 1994 a new, single, national department was established, and it was named Department of Education (DoE). The three former national departments and the homeland departments were ipso facto abolished. In December 1994, the four provinces were altered. Two were renamed but retained their boundaries, and the other two were split into seven new provinces. Each province duly established its own department of education.

**Scope of the DoE Collection.** The Collection at the Educ Archives is divided into the following series:

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**Rationale for collecting superseded books.** Once books published for teaching and learning become superseded their working life is over. They cease being current secondary sources for teachers and learners. Instead they become primary sources for researchers tracing patterns in the past. They therefore become archival in nature.

**Acquisition.** This collection is intended to grow as current books for teaching and learning in the Wits Education Library become superseded or worn-out and are withdrawn. The books in this collection come from various sources:

- bought by the Johannesburg College of Education (JCE)
- bought by the University of the Witwatersrand (Wits) -- ongoing

**Acquisition.** This collection is intended to grow as current books for teaching and learning in the Wits Education Library become superseded or worn-out and are withdrawn. The books in this collection come from various sources:

- supplied by the Transvaal Education department (TED)
- bought by the Johannesburg College of Education (JCE)
- bought by the University of the Witwatersrand (Wits) -- ongoing
- donated by individuals or institutions

**Copyright.** Copyright vests with the individual publishers.

**Scope of Collection 3: Superseded Books for Teaching and Learning (English).** The collection includes

- graded readers, which are targeted to neo-literates of particular ages;

**Historical note on the DET.** In the Apartheid era there were numerous departments of education, and each homeland had one. Black schools that were not in any of the homelands fell under the Department of Bantu Education. The Bantu Education Act was repealed in 1979 and replaced by a new law, which came into effect in January 1980. Thus was born the Department of Education and Training (DET). The earliest DET syllabuses in this collection are dated 1983, and the latest 1989. Once majority government came in 1994 the DET ceased to exist by December. In January 1995 the nine newly formed provinces took over control of all schools.

**Historical note on the departments of national education.** In 1984 a system of three parliaments was adopted. Three new over-arching departments of national education were accordingly established, one for each of the three parts of the tri-cameral parliament. All three departments were called Department of Education and Culture, but the subtitles differed. The department for whites was subtitled House of Assembly. The coloureds' department was subtitled House of Representatives, and the Indians' House of Delegates.

Once majority government came in 1994 the three departments of national education ceased to exist by December. In January 1995 a new, single, over-arching national department was established. This was called simply the Department of Education.
