Letter-book containing copies of letters signed by R.H. (Sir Robert Harland) who was Commander-in-Chief of H.M. Ships and Vessels in the East Indies. The letters are written from Fort St. George, Bombay and the Cape of Good Hope, being addressed to the Navy Board, Board of Ordnance, Philip Stephens (Admiralty). Josiah du Pre (President of Fort St. George), W. Hastings (Governor of Bengal), W. Hornby (President of Bombay), P.A. van der Para (President and Governor of the Dutch settlement in the East Indies), A. Wynch (President of Fort St. George) and others.

Subjects are provisions, appointments, treatment of the sick and deserters and disposition of ships in the sqadron.

Includes a diary kept from 13 October - 14 November 1774 at the Cape when his ship, the Northumberland, stopped for refreshment and repairs.
