My dear brother.

Do not be surprised to get my latter so late. When your last latter arrived I was say on a political tour of the Pree State and Matul, albeit a brief one. (In Matul they have established a strong Youth League and in the Pree State (Bloenfoutein) a Langue is eabryo). As my wife was not quite well them (by the way I have now get a sear names Catyoni Zanemyula Mda) the children have planed your letter swong my old letters, so that it was only recently that I came upon it.

Now concarring my coming there. I simply failed an account of the urgent call I had to make on Natal. At this late hour in the year, you will appreciate that it will prove difficult for me to come there, at least auring the term. I am sorry, nourades, I had to fail so badly. I found mycelf benned in, and much as I wished to come down I simply failed.

At the present moment I as busy making arrangements for the Congress Touth Conference to be held at Bloenfostein from the 14th to the 15th Becomber 1948. It will really start in the svening of 14th Becomber, 1948 and end in the afternoon ar evening of the following day. Further details will be sent in due course of time. Tour branch may send any number up to ten delegates. However, those members who wish to sitend will be free to de so - I mean in addition to the quote of delegates.

On the 16th December, I hope you are arare that an All-in Conference of Leaders from the A.A.C. and the A.H.C., as well as the rank and file, has been summand. The Youth League attitude will be formulated at our Fouth Conference. Memorils I shall issue a political statement in the Takundle" conserning the Conference of African people on the 16th December.

Eindly ds your best Comrade to send at least some delegates ar delegate to the Touth Conference. The lodging and boarding for is 7/6 per day. I should be glad to be given the approximate number of delegates beforehand. Further elegates that is will follow.
