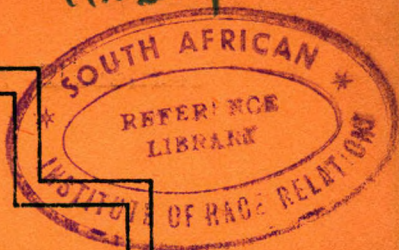

CARNEGIE NIE-EUROPESE BIBLIOTEEK, TRANSVAAL.

VERSLAG VIR DIE JAAR GEËINDIG 31 AUGUSTUS 1944.

Die Carnegie Nie-Europese Biblioteek is 'n inrigting wat 'n sentrale biblioteek te Germiston het, waarvan kaste boeke aan stedelike en plattelandse sentrums uitgestuur word. Sentrums word by skole, stadsgebiede, sendingstasies, mynkampe, ens., gestig.

Die Komitee wend pogings aan om Takbiblioteke in stedelike gebiede te stig, en om die Transvaalse Munisipaliteite aan te moedig om doeltreffende somme geld op hul jaarlikse begrotings te plaas, ten einde Nie-Europese Biblioteke binne hul eie dorpe op te rig.

Hierdie biblioteke word dan deur die betrokke Stadsrade onafhanklik bestuur, of val onder die toesig van die Carnegie Nie-Europese Biblioteek Komitee.

Hierdie verslag het betrekking tot laasgenoemde tipe alleen.

BIBLIOTEKE BINNE STEDELIKE GEBIEDE.

BENONI.—Die biblioteek in die Benoni Stadsgebied word in 'n spesiale gebou naby die skole en die „Seunsklub” gehuisves. 'n Voltydse maar ongekwalifiseerde bibliotekaresse is al jarelank by die Benoni Stadsgebied Biblioteek in diens.

Aantal lesers: 648. **Jaarlikse sirkulasie:** 3,028. **Boekevoorraad:** 745.

BOKSBURG (STIRTONVILLE).—Daar die vakante betrekking van Biblioteeks-assistent nie gevul is nie, was dit onmoontlik om iemand vanuit Germiston tweemaal per week te stuur om die biblioteek in die Superintendent se kantoor te beheer. Die Boksburgse Munisipaliteit het dit ook onmoontlik gevind om 'n bibliotekaris aan te stel. Gevolglik is dit besluit om hierdie boeke weg te neem. Daar is egter boeke in die Stirtonville Bantu Sentrum en die Stirtonville se Kleurlingskool.

Aantal lesers: 287. **Jaarlikse sirkulasie:** 1,607. **Boekevoorraad:** 190.

GERMISTON.—Gedurende die jaar het die Germistonse Munisipaliteit sy jaarlikse toelae vir die instandhouding van die Germistonse Nie-Europese Biblioteek van £226 tot £376 verhoog. Nou is dit moontlik om die onkoste van die Biblioteek te bestry. Die biblioteek huur 'n winkel naby die

Germistonse Stadsgebied en het 'n voltydse bibliotekaris (gematrikuleerd) in diens.

Aantal lesers: 810. Jaarlikse sirkulasie: 6,309. Boekevoorraad: 3,700.

KRUGERSDORP.—Die Superintendent van die Krugersdorpse Stadsgebied wend pogings aan om 'n versameling boeke vir die gebruik van sy twee stadsgebiede op te bou; by hierdie versameling word gevoeg die geleende boeke van die Sentrale Biblioteek. Die Stadsgebied Superintendent tree self as Bibliotekaris op.

Aantal lesers: 260. Jaarlikse sirkulasie: 422. Boekevoorraad: 238.

PRETORIA.—Gedurende die jaar het die Pretoriase Munisipaliteit toegestem om die Biblioteekkomitee 'n bedrag van £250 vir die stigting van 'n Nie-Europese Biblioteek by Marabastad te gee. Op 1 Maart 1944, het Mnr. Mbete, 'n ervarende bibliotekaris, in Pretoria begin werk. Die bestuur van die Pretoriase Nie-Europese Biblioteek is in die hande van 'n Subkomitee van die Transvaalse Carnegie Nie-Europese Biblioteekkomitee wat bestaan uit die Pretoriase lede van die komitee met twee gekoöpteerde lede—Mej. Nicholson van die Staatsbiblioteek en Mnr. Charles Christie.

Aantal lesers: 486. Jaarlikse sirkulasie: 1,542. Boekevoorraad: 397.

Daar is ook 'n Nie-Europese Biblioteek in Atteridgeville waar 'n deeltydse bibliotekaresse in diens is.

Aantal lesers: 107. Jaarlikse sirkulasie: 167. Boekevoorraad: 397.

ROODEPOORT.—'n Kas boeke word van die Sentrale Biblioteek uitgestuur en in die kantoor van die Stadsgebiedsuperintendent gehuisves. Die biblioteek is onder die beheer van 'n onopgeleide vrywillige werker.

Aantal lesers: 49. Jaarlikse sirkulasie: 143. Boekevoorraad: 50.

Daar is ook biblioteekboeke in die Roodepoort Kleurlingskool en die Roodepoort Indiëre Skool (sien lys van sentrums).

SPRINGS (PAYNEVILLE).—Die Munisipaliteit van Springs het 'n gedeelte van die Seunsklub-gebou afgestaan aan die biblioteek en beskik oor die dienste van 'n voltydse gematrikuleerde Nie-Europese bibliotekaresse.

Aantal lesers: 674. Jaarlikse sirkulasie: 3,918. Boekevoorraad, 635.

VEREENIGING.—Die Munisipaliteit van Vereeniging het een van sy stadsgebied huise tot die beskikking van die

biblioteek geplaas en laat sy Sports-organiseerder toe om deel van sy tyd aan biblioteek werk te bestee.

Aantal lesers: 178. Jaarlikse sirkulasie: 1,042. Boeke-voorraad: 844.

ANDER STEDE.—Brakpan en Randfontein bestuur onafhanklike biblioteekdienste vir die inwoners van hulle stadsgebiede.

Te Ermelo, Heidelberg, Klerksdorp, Piet Retief, Pietersburg, Potchefstroom, Potgietersrust, Standerton, Witbank en Zeerust kan lesers boeke uit die kaste vanaf die Sentrale Biblioteek gestuur leen. Die werk word deur onbetaalde vrywilligers gedoen.

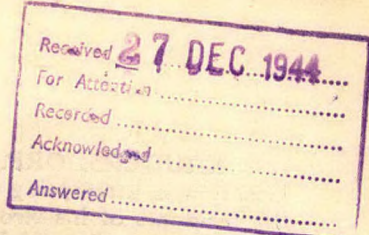

CARNEGIE NON-EUROPEAN LIBRARY, TRANSVAAL.

REPORT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31st AUGUST, 1944.

The Carnegie Non-European Library is an organisation which has a central library at Germiston, and distributes boxes of books to town and rural centres established at schools, locations, mission stations, compounds, etc.

The Committee endeavours to establish Branch Libraries in urban areas, and to encourage Transvaal Municipalities to spend adequate sums of money on Non-European libraries for their own towns. These libraries are then administered independently by the Town Councils concerned, or fall under the tutelage of the Carnegie Non-European Library Committee.

This report concerns itself with the latter type only.

LIBRARIES IN URBAN AREAS.

BENONI.—The Library in Benoni Location is housed in a special building near the schools and the Boys' Club. A full-time, but unqualified librarian, has been employed at Benoni Location for some years.

Membership: 648. **Annual Circulation:** 3,028. **Book Stock:** 745.

BOKSBURG (STIRTONVILLE).—Since the post of Library Assistant was not filled, it was found impossible to send anyone out from Germiston twice a week to administer the Library housed in the Superintendent's Office. The Boksburg Municipality was also not able to appoint a Librarian, so it was decided to withdraw these books. There are, however, deposits of books at the Stirtonville Bantu Centre and the Stirtonville Coloured School.

Membership: 287. **Annual Circulation:** 1,605. **Book Stock:** 190.

GERMISTON.—During the year the Germiston Municipality increased its annual grant for the maintenance of the Germiston Non-European Library from £226 to £376, thereby enabling the expenses of the library to be covered. The library rents a shop near the Germiston Location and employs a full-time librarian (Matriculated).

Membership: 810. **Annual Circulation:** 6,309. **Book Stock,** 3,700.

KRUGERSDORP.—The Superintendent of Krugersdorp Location is attempting to build up a collection of books for the residents of his two locations, supplemented by books on loan from the Central Library. The Location Superintendent himself acts as librarian.

Membership: 260. **Annual Circulation:** 422. **Book Stock:** 238.

PRETORIA.—During the year the Pretoria Municipality agreed to grant the Library Committee the sum of £250 for the establishment of a Non-European Library at Marabastad. On 1st March, 1944, Mr. Mbete, an experienced librarian, took up full-time duties at Pretoria. The affairs of the Pretoria Non-European Library are administered by a Sub-Committee of the Transvaal Carnegie Non-European Library, consisting of the Pretoria members of the committee with two co-opted members—Miss Nicholson, of the State Library, and Mr. Charles Christie.

Membership: 486. **Annual Circulation:** 1,542. **Book Stock,** 1,283.

There is also a Non-European Library at Atteridgeville, administered by a part-time librarian.

Membership: 107. **Annual Circulation:** 167. **Book Stock:** 397.

ROODEPOORT.—A box of books is sent out from the Central Library and housed in the office of the Location Superintendent. The library is managed by an untrained voluntary worker.

Membership: 49. **Annual Circulation,** 143. **Book Stock:** 50.

In addition to this deposit, there are also deposits of books in the Roodepoort Coloured School and the Roodepoort Indian School (see table).

SPRINGS (PAYNEVILLE).—Springs Municipality has placed a portion of the premises of the Boys' Club at the disposal of the library and employs a full-time African Librarian (Matriculated).

Membership: 674. **Annual Circulation,** 3,918. **Book Stock:** 655.

VEREENIGING.—The Vereeniging Municipality has placed one of the location houses at the disposal of the library and allows its Sports Organiser to devote part of his time to library work.

Membership: 178. **Annual Circulation:** 1,042. **Book Stock:** 844.

OTHER TOWNS.—Brakpan and Randfontein conduct independent library services for their location residents.

At Ermelo, Heidelberg, Klerksdorp, Piet Retief, Pietersburg, Potchefstroom, Potgietersrust, Standerton, Witbank and Zeerust, readers borrow books from the boxes sent on loan from the Central Library. The work is done by unpaid volunteers.

BOOK CIRCULATION, 1943/44.
