outline of the plan for PEOPLE'S
CONGRESS or CONGRESS OF THE PEOPLE.

The Executive will be meeting
early in March. It is necessary
to furnish members with a
memorandum setting ^{OUT} out
the plan indicating, inter alia,

- (1) objectives
- (2) plan of organizing: National
and local levels
- (3) any other relevant considerations

As the Working Committee
^{MUST} please officially ^{SEND} send out
 the memorandum to Executive
 members may you please
 let your date be the earliest
 date send them the memorandum
 they will use as a basis
 for setting out the official
 plan for submission to the
 Executive.

 this matter with him and
 agreed that you should ^{BE}
 asked to set out your ideas
 as proposer.
