## BANTU (URBAN AREAS)

*Provided that the State President may, after public inquiry by a person or persons appointed by him for that purpose, at which urban local authorities and other parties interested shall be entitled to be heard, declare by proclamation in the Gazette that as from a date to be specified therein, being not less than twelve months from the date of such proclamation, the provisions of this paragraph shall be suspended for a period to be stated in such proclamation or shall be withdrawn;*

<sup>1</sup>(d) *an amount calculated according to such formula based on the sale of Bantu beer during any particular financial year as the Minister may fix by notice in the Gazette and which shall be payable to the Consolidated Revenue Fund in the manner prescribed for the purposes mentioned in sub-section (2) of section nineteen bis of the Bantu Beer Act, 1962.*

<sup>2</sup>(3)bis. *The Bantu services levy fund shall be chargeable only with—*

(a) *the cost of administration of the Bantu Services Levy Act, 1952;*

(b) *any amounts which the Minister may in any particular case from time to time determine as a contribution towards the remuneration and allowances payable in terms of sub-section (4) of section seven of the said Act;*

(d) *any expenditure incurred by the urban local authority in connection with the provision of water, sanitation, lighting or road services outside a location, Bantu village or Bantu hostel under the control of that urban local authority, or outside any area approved by the Minister for future use for location, Bantu village or Bantu hostel purposes, provided such services are in the opinion of the Minister essential for the proper development of a location, Bantu village or Bantu hostel or of such other area;*

(e) *interest and redemption charges as may be approved by the Minister in respect of any loan raised by the urban local authority to finance any works or services referred to in paragraph (d);*

(f) *any amount which the Minister may approve as a loan or grant to the Bantu revenue account for the provision of water, sanitation, lighting or road services, subject to such interest charges and conditions of repayment as he may approve;*

(g) *any amounts which the Minister may, after consultation with the urban local authority, require it to pay to any other body, including any other urban local authority, in respect of adult male Bantu employed in the urban area of that urban local authority but residing in any area under the control of such other body in respect of which it provides water, sanitation, lighting or road services, and any amounts paid to any body in pursuance of a direction under this paragraph shall be deposited in the relevant account referred to in section three of the Bantu Services Levy Act, 1952.*

BANTU SERVICES LEVY ACT 1952 (No. 64/1952)

Financial position of the Bantu Services Levy Fund as at  
28th February, 1971.

The Local Advisory Committee at a meeting on the 17th April, 1971, resolved that the Town Clerk be requested to obtain a full report from the Non European Affairs and City Engineer's Departments setting out such details as the present financial position of the fund, projects at present being undertaken and projects which are being planned.

Annexure A indicates all approved projects, the value of each project, the expenditure as at 28th February, 1971, and the balance as at the same date.

Annexure B shows all projects for which applications have been submitted but have not yet been approved.

Annexure C is for projects that are in the course of preparation or are anticipated to be undertaken at a future date. No estimates are available but the total value is expected to range from R5 000 000 to R10 000 000.

Annexure D summarises the financial position as at the 28th February, 1971.

CONCLUSION

From Annexure D it is seen that there is a shortfall of R5 750 000 to finance future projects.

The approximate annual income is R1 860 000 or R155 000 per month. It would, therefore, require just over 37 months to make good the deficit. It must be pointed out that the amount of R10 000 000 will be required over a period in excess of 3 years but on the other hand the development envisaged in this report does not go any further than the completion of Pinville and Protea. No attempt has been made to budget for any expansion in terms of the Interim Report No.4. on the Bantu population and its housing and other requirements. If an additional 15 square kilometres are to be developed by 1980 for Bantu housing then it is evident that the demand on the Services Levy Fund will continue for a long time.

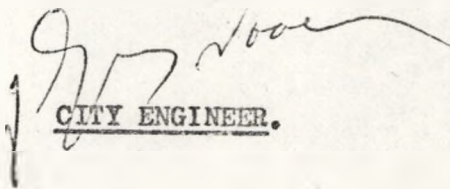
