S.S. hand still very poorly - fainted or trembled the Lectern - Dr. Sanders was sent for to see her, though she <sup>was</sup> better when he arrived in the evening - ordered her to remain in bed & eat <sup>this man went to 10:00 my poor husband</sup>
- 23<sup>o</sup> In P.M. said Mass & came to Evening address 8<sup>o</sup> Amelie fainted at Mass - S.G. was faint at 10-45, & the 8<sup>o</sup> in Charge a bit queer about 12-30 the weather being very hot & oppressive may have accounted for this weakness or the fact of the Community!! Mr. Chamberlain called - 8<sup>o</sup> in Charge went up to the School to see Superior.
- 24<sup>o</sup> 8<sup>o</sup> in Charge & 8<sup>o</sup> S.E. D-mars at the Cathedral. S.G. in Charge - S.S. in bed. 8<sup>o</sup> A. recting. The sweep came at 4-30 a.m. & swept the kitchen stove. 8<sup>o</sup> S. hand arose better at 10-30. Mr. Shaw came at 1-45 to see Sister Conferm & four girls. Uncle came. A trembler (Mr. Beauchamp Taylor called)

to 7 o'clock Mass with Communion & Min. Coe  
& girls made their Communions - 8<sup>th</sup> G. to 8 o'clock  
& Matins - 8<sup>th</sup> A.M. took a few girls to matins.  
8<sup>th</sup> S.M. returned from Arcadia in time for dinner  
Everyday - She went at Dr. <sup>2</sup>Parr's request to see the P.M.  
to come down to the School for Days Retreat - They  
lived in Cratory at Arcadia - Their Office being said  
in 8<sup>th</sup> Caroline's bedroom which is also shared by

5<sup>th</sup> 8 in charge 8 G to Mass at the Cathedral 8 S. D. in charge - 8 S. D. resting - During evening recreation Florence (Aunie Clarke) asked to be excused & returned no more - She had gone off home leaving her cap & apron in the bathroom - 8 in charge went to inform the police - She seemed to be well known to them - She is half silly & has fits -

6<sup>th</sup> In 2<sup>nd</sup> Pan Laid Mass & dismissed Alice immediately after - She went after dinner to Mr. Dodge with a view to returning to England with Mr. Dodge & her baby in December - 8 in charge went to see after Florence (Aunie Clarke) found her at her home, or

not wishing to return - She was discontented  
with the food, the D<sup>r</sup> leaving forbidding her meat  
on account of her frequent fits. Louisa Stone  
arrived - Mrs. Starling brought her. Dr<sup>r</sup> Peacey sent  
a young man to tighten up the tent. It had  
nearly collapsed. Dr<sup>r</sup> Parr came to oversee & children  
8<sup>th</sup> in charge went up to see Superior - Minnie went to  
bed before tea not feeling well. 8<sup>th</sup> S. Ward not very  
well.

7<sup>th</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> in charge said Prime & went to mass at the Cathedral  
taking with her Libbie & Ellen. 8<sup>th</sup> G<sub>r</sub> Schul matron  
just before breakfast. 8<sup>th</sup> Stella Ward went till breakfast  
time. 8<sup>th</sup> L. M. in charge - Minnie went to breakfast.  
8<sup>th</sup> Stella Ward took Ellen to Acadia Church Dr. Prime  
of Shaw came to see Superior & Sisters girls &  
matron - Agatha came back from Joburg - not being  
able to find any work to do & having no money. 8<sup>th</sup> Mary  
went to meet her & put her up in the nursery with her  
baby till some work can be found for her. Dr<sup>r</sup> Peacey  
called.

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
