1. SOUTH AFRICAN TERRORISM

One more indication o risno tide o terrorism & violence stemmno frm SA & spreadno thru out whole Sthn Af & furthr afield.

Two-fold attack directed both ag. SA's inside & outside SA And also direct & indirect intervention in the internal affairs o blk states.

Ths in turn achievd by various means:

- . by traing terrorists as individuals & orps:
- . by sabotage aimd at military & ec structure
- . by direct military incursions
- . by armo & financo anti-socialst grps
- . by assissinations

BOTSWANA, LESOTHO, SWAZILAND

hve hd bomb attcks, assassinations, incursion o SA's military forces & intelligence services; 2 Undercovr subversion & attacks on exiles & refugees. Burg last yr, numerous incursions (conservation officrs)

SA ref: Dava Pillay kidnppd, school, Manzini (Swazi) Dec 81 2 more exiled ANC membrs shot & killd whn car pursued by SA police June car bomb in Marsapa, Swazi, killd ANC & SACTU militants (Petrus & Jabb Nzima, 4 childrn

Few wks ago, Lesotho Minister Jobo Rempeta killd in series o murderous attcks by 'Lesothom Lib Army', known to b wkng wth SA. In July anothr leadng politican, Chakela, murdered.

SAN people & othr tribes being recruitdd to fight ag. Namibians - same type o destructive process we saw in Cambodia - deoradation

ZAMBIA operatng frm Caprivi strip to create 'no-gc area i Western Prov., Mixture o direct mil. agg. covert subversion & ec. disruption, enormous drain on Z money & resources to combt these.

ZIMBABWE

murdr o Joe Gqabi, Harare, 1st yr, poignant R traind hm in Guardian office. ANC rep. Followng mnth, massive explosion at Inkoms Barracks destroyd munitions value R50 million Dec 81 7 killd, 120 injurd in Harare explosion aimd at senior ZANU officials; Mugabe accusd SA of plan.

Formr Rhodesian soldiers gone to SA take part.

ANGOLA & MOZAMBIQUE

bt most open military attks are in Ang & Moz. An EEC Commission learnd tt SA armd forces involvd in more thn 2,000 separate operations inside Angola durg 81 alone, include 100 bombg raids, 1700 reconnaisance missions, 53 troop landgs, etc.

SA forces occupy 40,000 sq kilos Kunene & also of course operate thru ally Savimbi wth US supor Angols borne brunt o military attcks, bt Moz also subject.

SA coldiers recently enterd in full army uniform armd & equippd, 9-man reconneisance miceion. Since Mstola raid, whn 12 SA's murdered in open military incursion, SA troops on bordrs hve joind army actions with ec. sabotage, destroyng crucias1 transport links; road, rail & pipeline connections between Moz & Zimb, an also in Ang, where economic targts sch as oil refinery in Luanda & Beira-Umtali pipeline.

ATTACKS MORE AUDACIOUS - Nov attptd Seychelles coup. whn merceneries hd pssports issued by SA Ministr o Int, wth permission on highest level.

AND, OF COURSE, AS FAR AS LONDON - ANC offices

All these hve 3-fold purpose:

- Directd ag. ANC & SWAPO, bth as increasing form o terrorism, & t physical destruction of ind & intimidation o othrs
- 2. to bring pressure to bear on Af states withdraw support fr nat lib movemnts in SA & Namibia
- 'Destablisation' to make it imp. fr states to dev & strengthn econ omiesz, pursue nation! reconstruction, end dependence on SA which seeks permanention

Therefore becomes clear tt bombs sent to Ruth and de Braganca were logical & important part o this total programme.

& in all these actions, as with murdr bomb sent to R, not imp. whethr directly prepared in SA or whethr done thru othr orgs & gps: t direction t technical knowledge, comes frm heart o SA, t traing, planng, instigstng, financng stems directly from Pretoria.

Ths gives force by Gen Johan Coetzee, one day aftr R's murder, tt SA is committed to t uncompromisin pursuit & destruction o blk nationalist guerillas wherever they may be.

2. THE EARLY YEARS

Article in RDM stated: 'It is acceptd tt though Prof First's work was principally in the academic field, she was a person of considerable political importance.'

Wrong. Wk primeip in all fields totally politically motivated & directd. Importance o R's life is the imp every facet o hr wk its strength ws ths politic. motivation.

POLITICAL HOUSEHOLD. Parents, CP. Joind YCL. thn CP, whose early support fr fight fr nat lib made it inevitably ally o ANC.

In ths way, R came to knw many ANC people, wkd wth thm as colleague & friend.

(Early pol act) 46 Mine strike, leaflets. Journalist career begn 46 & one yr later, BETHAL, wth Gert Sibande.

Two things to considr whn recallng 'scoops'. <u>1st</u>, they came abt boos o paper's close contacts wth people; only paper to support their struggle; they came to paper wth their stories. <u>2nd</u>, hr wk as journalisticnever indiv scoops like so many press revelations. They were part of uncoverng of whole ap. systm, & bound up wth import. pol. campaigns. (as wth potato boycott)

Thru the probing & crusadg journalism, R came to direct contact wth life o blk people, nt just fringes, bt intimate insight into its realities.

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our political lives were initegrated, but so were our social lives. Relaxed tyther weekends, went on holidays together....

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The Slove girls, like our children, beame accustomed to to men whose heavy boots scarred parquet floors, strippg bookshelves, desks, drawers. Our children, our homes, might look like others in our suburbs, but

A first bannd aftr returng to SA frm SWA, collecting material fr bk, stll outstandg & useful. In SWA, nt just journalist seeking material - knew wht she wantd, who to see, & hr pol. contacts made poss to reach blk leadrs & knw their probles

Finally bannd frm writng, publisding, prohibitd frm enterg premises o any ppr or publication, R startd librarian course as poss nw career. She ws in Univsty library whn SB'scame to arrest hr in 63. RIVONIA:

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4. EXILE

R lovd Ldn, stimulatng, 'town girl'. Bt fr R, as fr exiles, thrust o wk ws changd.

Stll tremendsly active, nw in AAM & ANC; demand as speakr, writer, policy-makr.

Enormously busy & productive: vistd Af ovr period o yrs to write BARREL OF A GUN. Co-authored the SA CONNECTION - again valuable weapon evn today. Book on LIBYA

Midwife to 2 othr bks, Oginga Odinga & Mbeki's Peasants Revolt, Publishd while he on Robben ks.

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Last bk, togethr wth Anne Scott, ws Schreiner.

PERSONAL TESTIMONY: knw hr long time, bt yrs before I really came. to knw hr.

Brilliant, supr intellect, probing,, questioning mind, independent & not sfraid o challenging acceptd views.

The made some uncomfortable - no one likes to hve to rethink entrenchd positions.

SHAW: T reasonable man adapts hmself to t wrld; t unreasonable one persists in tryg to adapt t wrld to himself. Therefore all progress depends on t unreasonable man.

She ws oftn impatient, particluarly o fools. Many men find it hard to accept very clever women. She was restless, immensely quick, include. Bt she ws not arrogant or self-imporant, Recognise tt change & growth are inherent qualities of + life process.

5. MAPUTO

R returnd to her roots whn she went to Moz. Removd frm tt Western Milieu of academic debate. Returnd to wk directly relatd to SA struggle, to help transform ths poor country so dependent on SA into ind. soc. state.

It ws as the EVERYTHNG CAME TOGETHR AT MAPUTO

- * t lifelong traing in digging up facts, in research & investigation
- * the reporter's yrs tt hd opened up fr hr t life o those othrs, t great blk majority o SA's, t miners, t migrant wkrs, t deprivd people
- * her experience o t lsw & o courts, o prison & isolation
- * hr academic experience in Britain, & refing as a teachr, public speakr, lecturer.
- * her creative writing & anti-aparthed activities durg 15 yrs o exile in England
- * her penetrating Marxist understandg o Moz's needs.

At Maputo, headed internat. team as research dir, & drew on all ths rch past to help initiate plans & projects tt wld b viable both frm an economic & also a socio-political standpoint. Hanlon: ...

In her 4 yrs in Moz, RE did wht most academics on the left only dream of: she creatéd a centre of activist research helping to transform a society... she workd fr tt transformation because she saw t victory of socialism in Moz as crucial fr t developmnt o socialism in SA. Clearly, t ap. regime agrees ...

T Moz Miner - pastng up, pix, layouts. Othr projects were in vital areas o industry & ag.

She continued to participate i t wk o t ANC, & in AA activites both nationally & internationally

R helpd shape many policies & mch activity in CP & in ANC & ANA BUT SHE IN TURN ws shaped by t orgs thru which she workd. It was 2-way dialectica process - t reaction o the indiv on t collective, & of t collective movemnt on the individual.

Hr bks remain, but the living memorial to RF is our movement. Even if we cld distance ourselves from t personal **sor**row, which many of us cannot, we could not lessen t political loss.
