





We read that all permits and obstacles in the way of multi-racial sports will be removed by amendments to the laws, such as the Group Areas Act, the Separate Amenities Act; the Liquor Act and the Bantu Urban Act.

What is the benefit in playing sports together and having our families and friends prosecuted and ejected from their homes and businesses while the GROUP AREAS ACT is on the STATUTE BOOK ? Where is the gain in being able to play in a "GHETTO" and if you want to visit a friend you would be prosecuted for not having a permit etc. etc.

The answer is simple. The oppressor cannot do without our cooperation to regain international sports memebrship. We cannot and will not give that co-operation to them without them giving us full citizenship of our country.



I look forward, with great pleasure, to the first inter-provincial of our Board to be held in Roshnee. The developement of the organisers, Vaal United Cricket Club, from the time of the inception of the Board five years ago has been quite dramatic, fielding teams in the first, second, third and junior divisions of the Board's league competitions, which no doubt augurs well for the future.

I am confident that their undertaking into hosting the Transvaal – Natal game will be successful and the fact that the clash will be keenly contested will leave happy memories of the three days spent at the grounds in Roshnee.

I wish to take this opportunity to once again expound our demands: 1. Cricket in South Africa must have one non-racial, not multi-national, national body to control and administer the sport. 2. Every provincial body must consist of unreservedly open clubs. 3. All training, coaching and playing facilities must be open. 4. No teams must tour overseas or visiting sides be entertained until non-racial cricket has been achieved —"clandestine " tours must end. 5. Schools' sport must be played on a completely non-racial basis. The separate school systems breed racialism and can never provide equal opportunities for school sports. 6. The restrictive and humiliating acts of Parliament such as the Group Areas Act, Separate Amenities Act, Liquor Act, etc., must be abolished.
