

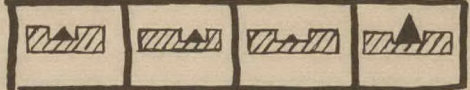

### HOW TO AIM AND FIRE

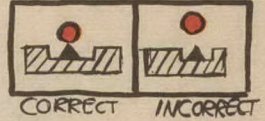
① HOLD THE WEAPON STEADY

CORRECT: INCORRECT →



② TAKE CAREFUL AIM.  
THE FRONT SIGHT OF THE WEAPON  
MUST BE LINED UP WITH THE  
REAR SIGHT, AND BOTH SIGHTS  
MUST BE LINED UP ON THE TARGET.

THE TARGET  
MUST REST ON  
TOP OF THE  
FRONT SIGHT



CORRECT INCORRECT

③ AIM AT THE  
BIGGEST PART  
OF THE TARGET;  
WITH A MAN, THE  
MIDDLE OF THE  
BODY, NOT THE  
HEAD.



④ CONTROL  
YOUR  
BREATHING  
SO

AS TO KEEP THE WEAPON  
STEADY.

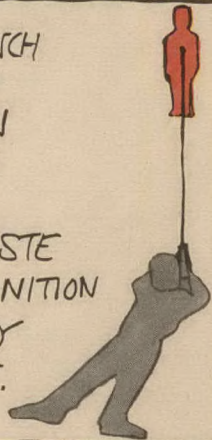
TAKE A DEEP BREATH, LET  
OUT HALF OF IT, HOLD THE  
REST OF IT, THEN BEGIN TO  
SQUEEZE THE TRIGGER.



⑤ SQUEEZE THE TRIGGER GENTLY.  
DO NOT PULL OR JERK IT.  
JUST APPLY SLOW STEADY  
PRESSURE ON THE TRIGGER  
UNTIL A SHOT GOES OFF.

⑥ DO NOT FLINCH  
OR JERK IN  
ANTICIPATION  
OF THE GUN  
GOING OFF.

DO NOT WASTE  
YOUR AMMUNITION  
MAKE EVERY  
SHOT COUNT.





THEY WERE TAUGHT TO MAKE  
AND USE SIMPLE HAND-GRENADES.



TO MAKE BLACK POWDER:

TAKE:-

75 PARTS OF SALPETRE  
15 PARTS OF CHARCOAL  
10 PARTS OF SULPHUR  
GRIND EACH OF THESE  
SEPARATELY TO POWDER. MIX  
TOGETHER WITH WATER  
INTO A PASTE. WHEN DRY,  
GRIND CAREFULLY TO A  
POWDER AGAIN. HARD  
RUBBING, OR A FLAME  
COULD MAKE IT EXPLODE.

THE FUSE.

EITHER USE ONE FROM A  
FIRE CRACKER. OR MAKE  
ONE FROM A LENGTH OF  
COTTON CORD SOAKED IN  
SALPETRE AND WATER.  
WHEN DRY IT WILL BURN.

YOU NEED A LENGTH THAT WILL TAKE 3 SECONDS TO BURN.

- ① TAKE A  
TIN CAN  
WITH A  
LID THAT  
FITS TIGHT.



- ② FILL  
WITH A  
MIXTURE  
OF BLACK  
POWDER  
METAL  
FRAGMENTS  
AND NAILS



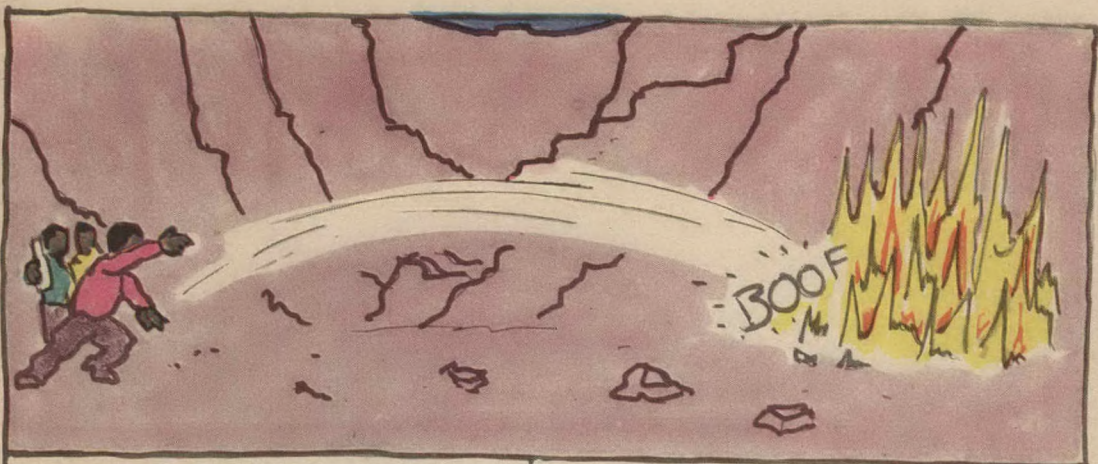
- ③ PUT THE  
FUSE IN  
THROUGH  
A HOLE  
IN THE LID.



- ④ COVER  
THE TOP  
WITH  
CEMENT  
OR PLASTIC  
PADDING  
TO SEAL  
THE LID  
TIGHT AND  
HOLD THE FUSE.







THEY WERE ALSO SHOWN THE FREEDOM-FIGHTER'S SIMPLEST WEAPON — THE PETROL BOMB.

$\frac{3}{4}$  FILL THE BOTTLE AS SHOWN IN THE PICTURE. THEN, EITHER ① CORK AS SHOWN AND FASTEN A FUSE (MADE LIKE THE GRENADE FUSE) TO THE NECK OR ② SIMPLY STUFF A RAG OR COTTON WASTE SOAKED IN OIL OR PETROL IN THE NECK TO SERVE AS BOTH CORK AND FUSE. LIGHT FUSE WITH A MATCH AND, THROW.

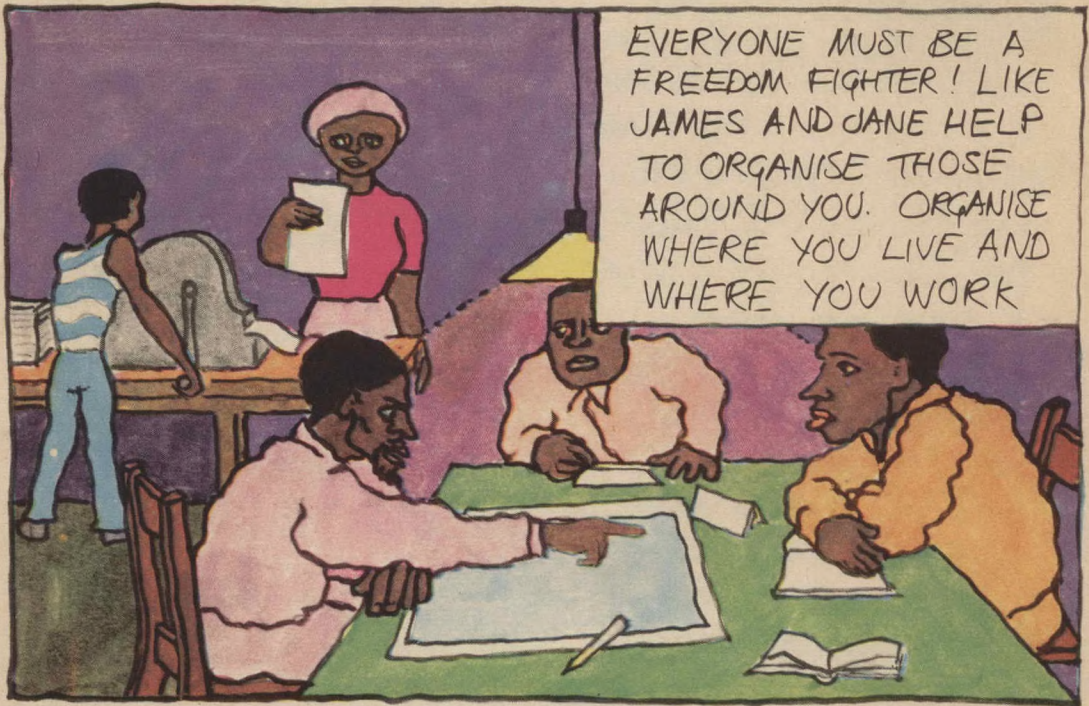

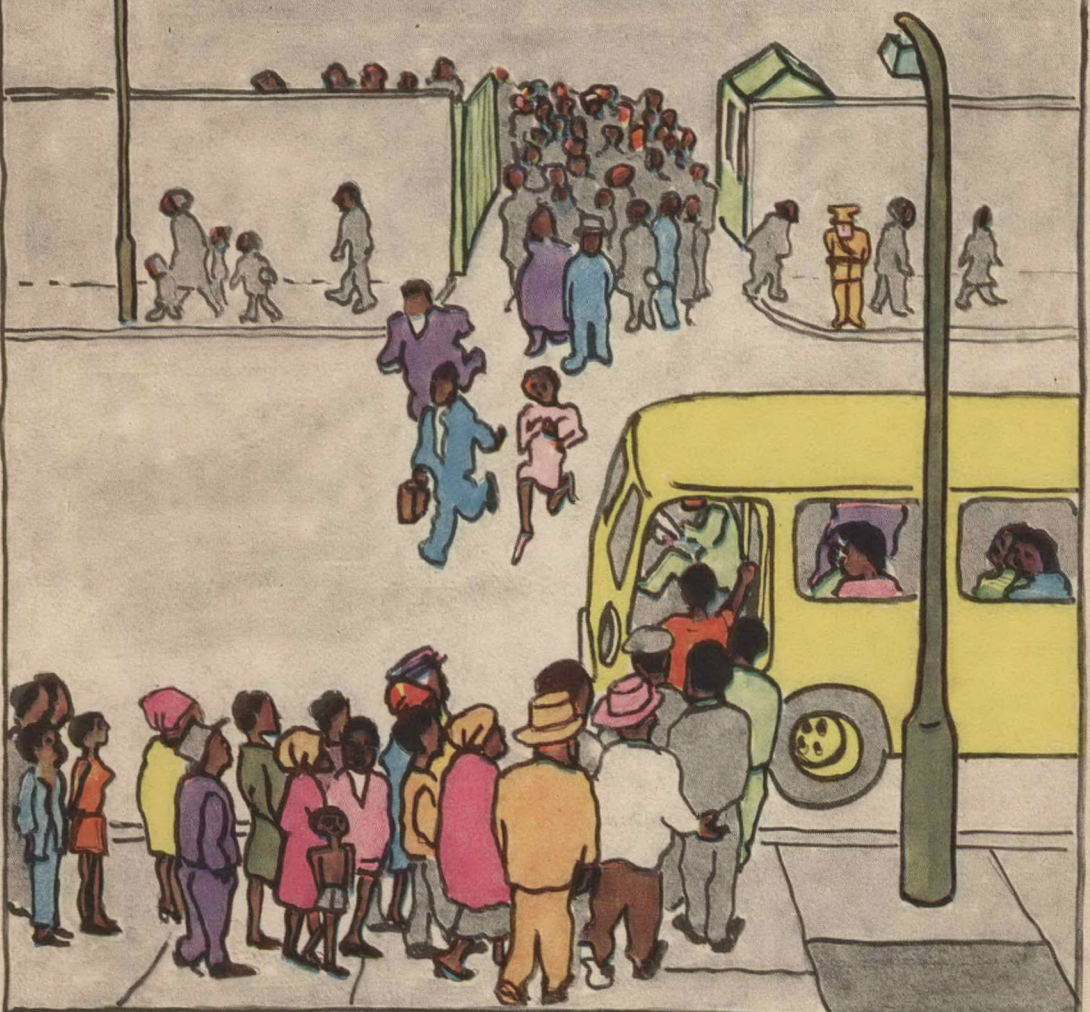
