





TO MAKE BLACK POWDER:

TAKE :- 75 PARTS OF SAUPETRE 15 PARTS OF CHARCOAL GRIND EACH OF THESE SEPARATELY TO POWDER. MIX TOGETHER WITH WATER INTO A PASTE. WHEN DRY, GRIND CAREFULLY TO A POWDER AGAIN. HARD RUBBING, O'R A FLAME COULD MAKE IT EXPLODE.

THE FUSE

EITHER USE ONE FROM A FIRE CRACKER OR MAKE ONE FROM A LENGTH OF COTTON CORD SOAKED IN SAUPETRE AND WATER. WHEN DRY IT WILL BURN. YOU NEED A LENGTH THAT WILL TAKE 3 SECONDS TOBURN.

(1) TAKE A TIN CAN WITH A LID THAT FITS TIGHT.



(e) FILL WITH A MIXTURE OF BLACK POWDER METAL MENTS AND WAILS



3 PUT THE FUSE IN THROUGH AHOLE INTHELLD




4 COVER THE TOP WITH CEMENT OR PLASTIC PADDING TOSEAL THE LID TIGHTAND HOLD THE FUSE.







SHOWN IN THE PICTURE.
