## Beware of Malan's Road to Slavery

Datum 27/9/55

NEW PASS BOOKS ARE BOOKS TO MAKE YOU SLAVES. You are stuffed that this is an Exemption. It is even worse than the old Passes. It is meant to tighten up "Control" and drive Africans out of towns. Any black mark against your name in the book means you carry it with you all your life as a mill-stone round your neck!

2 VERWOERD'S PLAN TO REMOVE "BLACK SPOTS" is meant to throw out 75,000 Non-Europeans from their homes in Sophiatown, Newclare and Western Native Township. Where will they be sent? To build shanties in the veld. People of Alexandra, Ladyselbourne and other areas watch out! It's your turn next. Stand by the Western Areas!

THE GROUP AREAS ACT, like the Verwoerd Plan, is meant to clear out all Non-Europeans from cities and towns to become "CHEAP LABOUR" on the mine and farms.

3 COLOUR BAIT ON THE RAILWAYS IS WORSE THAN EVER. Trains are always late and dangerously overcrowded. Apartheid at stations and now the BARRIER SYSTEM make us herd like cattle, threatened by armed police, made to wait and miss trains. They are out to provoke us beyond endurance.

4 MINISTER SCHOEMAN'S NEW "NATIVE LABOUR" (SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES) BILL is meant to stop African workers from discussing and negotiating their demands on the bosses directly or through trade unions. "Indunas" will be appointed to sell us. This is a way to make our wages even lower, to turn the workers into slaves.
