

**WP vs Transvaal
5-7 January
1991
in Johannesburg**

Great batting by Viljoen, White and Thomas earns WP a draw

THE BATTING efforts of new cap Andre Viljoen (48) and Nazeem White (57) stood out like beacons as the rest of the WP top and middle order succumbed to the pace and seam of Jack and Hussein Manack, who shared seven wickets between them.

After Viljoen and White had added 85 for the 3rd wicket, to lay a solid platform at 117/3, the rest of the WP batsmen failed to capitalise, collapsing to 168 all out.

At 150/4, the home side seemed set to take a substantial first innings lead, but Faiek Davids (4/28) triggered a middle-order collapse, which saw Transvaal lose their last six wickets for only 39 runs.

At 87/5 in their second innings, WP were in dire straits, but a record unbeaten sixth wicket stand of 122 between Yunus Thomas (75*) and Nazeem White (64*) guided the visitors to a secure 209/5 before rain intervened.
