My dear Comrade,

This is to inform you that we returned here from Nyasaland on Monday 12th instant and found our people all in good spirit. I wrote to you from Nyasaland and I hope you received my letter. I shall be glad if you put something in Ilanga Lase Natal about my visit in Nyasaland and our safe return. The Nyasaland Government were kind to us and gave me facilities to travel ~~in~~ transit through Southern Rhodesia thus, avoided travelling again through Portuguese territory.

Nyasaland is a very interesting country where Africans are permitted to develop according to their abilities as no restrictions are placed in their way.

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In government offices, banks, Post Offices, telegraphic offices, etc., you find Africans are in control. This applies as well in hospitals. Africans are permitted to drink in public bars alongside Europeans. African women are also allowed. No permits or exemptions are required. Africans drive trains with guards and firemen also Africans. Two Africans are members of the legislative Council and are referred to as "Honourable". I addressed one meeting at Blantyre of African intellectuals who demanded of me that I should settle in the Country of my birth in order to lead them in their political struggle. It was a very interesting meeting and I told them that it was impossible for me to change my domicile.

Again permit me to thank you on behalf of myself and my wife for the provision you so kindly gave us during our short stay in Durban. Is it possible for us both to meet in Bloemfontein next month during Conference time?
