THE DEPARTURE FROM THE UNION REGULATION ACT, 1955.

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO LEAVE THE
REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA PERMANENTLY.

IMPORTANT (i) In terms of the provisions of section 6, read with section 2, of the departure from the Union Regulation Act, 1955, a person to whom a permit to leave South Africa (including South West Africa) permanently has been issued may not, after having left South Africa (including South West Africa) return thereto.

(ii) If such a person should return to South Africa (including South West Africa), he will be prosecuted and is, as a conviction, liable to imprisonment without the option of a fine, for a period of not less than three months and not exceeding two years [section 8 (1) (a)].

INSTRUCTIONS.

- The applicant's certificate of birth or other evidence of nationality may be required.
- The fee for the issue of a permit is R2 which must be remitted with the application in the form of cash, money or postal order (not stamps or cheques). If sent by post, the packet must be registered and the postage paid.
- All women and children of 16 years and over, require separate permits. Applicants who are under 21 years of age must produce a letter from both parents or legal guardians concurring to the issue of a permit.
- Two recent, clear, unmounted photographs (head and shoulders, full face) size 2½ inches by 1½ inches of the applicant must be sent. It is essential that one of the two photographs of the applicant should be certified on the back by the Magistrate, Justice of the Peace or Commissioner of Oaths who signs the application, to be a true photograph of the applicant.
- An applicant in South Africa/South West Africa must produce a certificate from a Receiver of Revenue to the effect that he/she has discharged his/her income tax obligations, or is not liable to pay income tax before a permit can be issued.
- In order to comply with the requirements of the Department of Bantu Administration and Development, a Bantu applicant should interview the local Bantu Affairs Commissioner.
