My friend,

I have been directed by His Honour the Acting Administrator to inform you that Igoritala, a sub-chief of Moshetti's has complained to His Honour that you are in the habit of demanding payment from him and his people in respect of cattle sent to drink at the Mautyami. And to inform you that you have no right to demand any such payment and that in dry seasons all stock in that part of the Settagoli Reserve must be allowed free access to the Mautyami.

His Honour has not overlooked the settlement made by Messrs Tillaud and Wright and Lieutenant Bates in November 1887 when the dispute between Phoi and yourself as to the respective rights in the Settagoli

Reserve was satisfactorily arranged,
but you should understand
that this settlement between
yourself and Phoi could not be
held to affect in any way the
de facto grazing rights over the
whole reserve which were secured
to Mashette under the Land
Commission Award.

Iqoitata has therefore been
informed that you have no
right to deny access to or
make any charge for water
in the Maritani and Puii bed.
