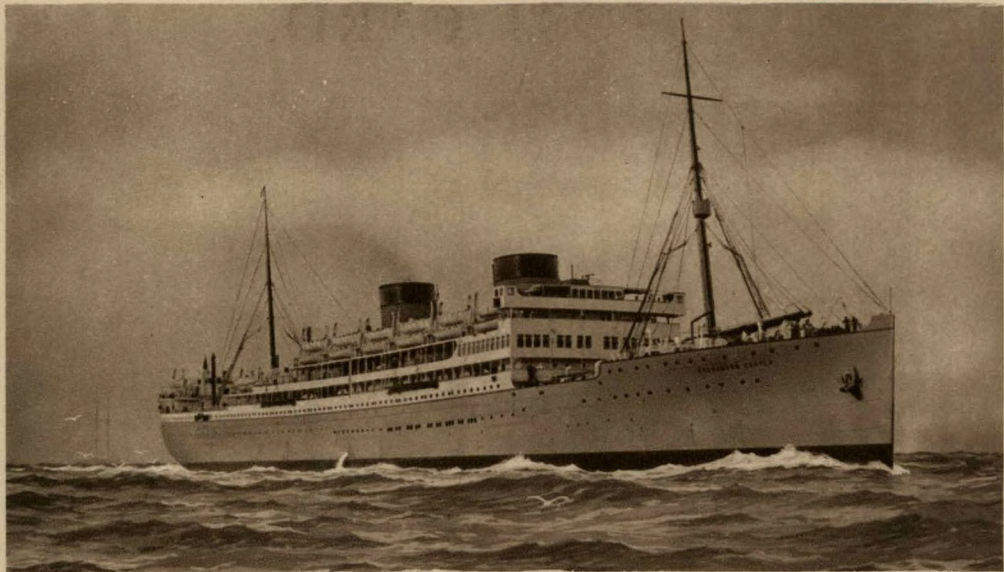

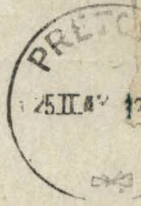

Dear Dr,

I took somebody to the Yard this afternoon, to show him the chimneys and when we came there Mrs Youa paid me the sum of five pounds as a first instalment for the refund of the stolen money. Of course she has not paid her own rent for last month. She also asked me to give her, your address. You know Dr, I want us to start right away with the cementing of the well, before anything else, because, I think it is more important to have water ready for use than to fix up the chimneys first. Another thing is that as long as we have no water in the yard, the tenants will keep on getting water from Mr Wisib's and that means another heavy bill in the near future. I am going to try our timber yards here for materials of fixing the pit. I have no money, but I think

they can give me the goods I want on credit. So please Mr tell me soon, if what I think is right or wrong. The fellow who is going to do the job wants £3.10. for fixing the pit only. i.e cementing and putting up poles for the drawing of water. About chimneys, we failed to get a ladder, so he couldn't go up to see the chimneys so, we have come to no terms yet. I shall let you know later. Inclosed herewith please find the sum of five pounds referred to, at the beginning of this letter. We wish you and your family a happy Xmas and a lucky New Year.



TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This is to certify that on this date I examined bearer, Mrs. Miriam Nhlapo, a married woman and a School Teacher by profession, and find:-

- (a) Short stocky Zulu woman of light brown complexion aged about 35 years.
- (b) She drags her right leg when she walks.
- (c) Dark area of contusions about 4 by 3 inches wide with an area of abrasion approximately an inch and a half wide to the right of the lumbar vertebrae just above the sacro-iliac joint. The area is compatible with forcible impact of a blunt object or instrument.
- (d) The area is tender on pressure and also area around the lower half of kidney.
- (e) Patient is menstruating and shows marked tenderness in the lower abdomen. The periods are alleged to be seven days before the usual time. This is probably due to the impact of the blow causing congestion in kidneys and ovaries.
- (f) Hot fomentations and ointment were ordered.
