Recalling past experiences, I have maked her if she is certain that she will in fact stay at the hotel, and a way are that she is certain.

Also, is it possible to let me know the cost of the accommodation at the hotel so that I can give the money to Mrs Schukwe. I don't suppose there is any chance of finding some kind soul down there who would be willing to take over the account? This, I hasten to add, is merely a passing thought, because my purpose is not chiefly to ask you to wring the money from someone, but to fix up the booking.

I have been wanting to write to you for many months now to ask whether it was possible to arrange for that chair for Bob which we discussed when I was in Cape Town early in the year.

I hope you are keeping well.
