October 1985

- Sandy Jocelyn phoned Natal command to ask an SADF official to debate against ECC on PNRB campus. She was told "we don't debate our enemies we kill them."

January 1986

- An ECC member's Anton Krone - Boss was visited by security police. They were

told that Anton was using
KwaZulu vehicles for ECC work
and ~~that~~ questioned people
about Anton.

March

April 1986

A Black South woman - Mary
Gaudner was picked up and
questioned during an ECC
picket.

April 1986

Mark Gaudau & Karen Krone

- 30.6.86: Johnny Kaplan and Hilary Reynolds taken to Loop St police station and photographed. They were then taken to Umkomaas Commando Army Base for interrogation. They were released 3 hrs later
- 1.7.86: Phillip Le Hausse was questioned at Umkomaas Commando. His house and office were also raided.
- 2/3.7.86: Jacqui Boule's house was visited by MI and various threats made.
- 18.7.86: Gill Waye was picked up at the petrol station and taken to Umkomaas Commando for questioning.
- 28.7.86: MI went to the workplace of Johnny Kaplan and requested to be shown around. ^{was}
- 19.8.86: Anton Krone visited and questioned for 2 hrs. Documents regarding his objection to the board for religious objection were removed.
- October: anton revisited and his documents returned.

A F F I D A V I T

I, the undersigned MARK ELLISON PATRICK, do hereby make Oath and say:

1.

I am an adult male Medical Doctor, and I reside at 60 Howick Road, in the district of Pietermaritzburg.

2.

On the 1st day of September, 1987 I was at the abovementioned address. At approximately 11 p.m., the dogs began to bark furiously. In order to determine the source of their concern I left the house and proceeded down a path between the motor vehicle garage and our neighbour's wall.

3.

From that location I saw a red Toyota LDV motor vehicle proceeding very slowly down Howick Road.

4.

The vehicle stopped beyond our driveway. A white female, dressed in black clothes, got out of the Toyota motor vehicle and entered our driveway. I saw her place something on the bonnet of SALLY DIANA HOWES' motor vehicle, which was parked in our driveway at that time.

5.

In order to confront this woman I went around the garage to meet her at the gate. As I reached the gate I saw her running back to the said Toyota LDV motor vehicle, which then drove off. As it drove off both occupants turned around and saw me. Apart from noticing that the driver was a white male, I was not able to discern any recognisable features. At that point I made a mental note

of the motor vehicle's registration number, which was ND 369723, as well as mentally noting the fact that the number plate was not in the centre of the vehicle, but placed towards the left hand side of the rear of the motor vehicle.

6.

I then inspected the motor vehicle of Ms Howes, and found that a sticker had been placed on the bonnet of the motor vehicle which read "ECC - Peace off", a copy whereof is attached hereto marked "Annexure A". I have noted many copies of the sticker stuck at various locations in the city.

6.

I, accompanied by Ms Howes, then decided to follow the Toyota motor vehicle to get confirmation of the number plate. We drove down Howick Road into Commercial Road and found the same motor vehicle parked outside the Capital Towers Hotel in Commercial Road. No-one was in the motor vehicle.

7.

I could determine that it was the same vehicle that had stopped outside my house as the registration number read ND 369723, as well as the fact that the number plate was positioned in the same place. Furthermore the Toyota LDV was somewhat unusual in shape, and accordingly easily recognisable.

I waited for some time and then returned home.
