**MY FRIENDS,**

Among the many pleasing duties devolving upon a Christian community, I think it will readily be admitted that one of the first is to maintain and uphold by all practicable means the sanctity of the last resting place of the bodies of our dear departed relations and friends.

Our own houses are generally furnished with suitable attention to our ordinary comfort and convenience, whereas I grieve to remark that the graves of those we loved whilst here on earth, and the Church-yards in which their mortal remains are deposited are too often neglected, if not forgotten.

I purpose, God willing, that no such heavy charge (during the few remaining years I may yet be permitted to remain among you) shall be laid against the members of the "dear old Church of our Native Land." It is intended to enlarge the Cemetery Chapel, in Durban, and to make it sufficiently commodious for 30 or 40 persons who may from time to time attend the funeral train of their deceased relatives.

The building may also be profitably employed on each succeeding Sabbath by using it as a Sunday-school room for children at the west end of our now populous town. A sum of Fifty pounds is urgently needed to carry into effect this most desirable object.

This call, I doubt not, will readily be responded to by every individual who values the memory of those "not lost, but gone before," who are now awaiting the sound of the Trumpet of the great Judgment Day to be reunited, with those they loved on earth, in the Kingdom of Heaven—which may God of His infinite mercy grant, through the merits and mediation of Jesus Christ our Lord.
