We the undersigned, Chief and Councillors of the Barolong Nation, in the name of Natives People of Bechuanaland do hereby commend our cousin SOLOMON TSHEKISHO PLAATJE of Kimberley and Mafeking to represent to the best of his ability, the conditions of the natives of Bechuanaland under the UNION GOVERN-MENT, and we charge him to obtain for us from HIS MAJESTY'S SECRETARY OF STATE for the Colonies, a renewal of the assurances made to us in Mafeking in the year A. D. 1903, by the Right Honourable J. Chamberlain M. P., respecting the safeguard embodied in the annexation Act of 1895, And we further commend him and our case to the serious yet kindly attention of the Aborigenes Protection Society, the Native Races Committee, the Wesleyan Missionary Society and all Christian people in England.
