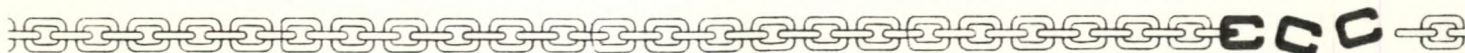

*As we have been involved in a major build-up to our latest nationally co-ordinated campaign as National Treasurer I have been very worried about where we are to get the funds. Yours was very good news. Your donation of 8000 dollars will be very usefull. Thank-you very much. I shall inform you as soon as we recieve the money.*

*You might know that I met a number of your colleagues when they were here in January, as guests of the SACBC. It was very good to meet with them and I really enjoyed taking them around for two of the days. In that time they met with members of the End Conscription Campaign, who thouroughly enjoyed the opportunity to meet with people who are similarly concerned in other parts of the world.*

*The campaign at the moment is picking up incredible momentum. Our 'Working for a Just Peace' National campaign, is really managing to capture the imagination of many members of the public. It has also helped to develop our organisational links with members of the Black and Afrikaans communities. The latter being a particularly important development. Their is a lot of talk of translating the Declaration and the title of the campaign into Afrikaans. This is particularly important as we have recently launched a new region in the heart of the Afrikaans establishment, Stellenbosch.*

*Anyway, that is us very briefly. I have almost completed the financial statement for 1985 and will send it to you in the next month. This has been extremely difficult as the security police 'detained' and never released all our national and Johannesburg regions financial records during the State of Emergency. This has meant a painstaking recreation of these records which is obviously difficult. I hope this has not inconvenienced you too much. With this report I will send you a detailed and brief (easily read) report of our activities over the last year. I hope this will make it easier for your work for us over their. We will also send you another package of material for your use, aroud June.*



RECORD OF AGREEMENT

NOW WHEREAS the End Conscription Campaign ("ECC") and DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE have reached agreement on a project to further a mutually shared interest to promote peace and understanding in South Africa.

AND NOW whereas the aforementioned parties have deemed fit to set down in writing the content of such agreement.

THE parties hereby confirm the agreement reached between them as follows:

1. The ECC will promote peace in Southern Africa and in order to further such object they will produce various publications and pamphlets and audio-visual material concerned with a peaceful solution to South Africa's problems and a critical awareness of compulsory military conscription, and maintain a standing office to achieve the aforesaid object of producing the said material.


2. The ECC hereby grants the right to the copyright in the said publications including the right to reproduce the whole or parts of the said publications to display and to sell the said publications in the country of CANADA.
3. Development and Peace hereby agrees in exchange for the said rights to the publications and materials produced by the ECC to make available to the ECC the amount of \$8,000 which sum shall be paid over to the ECC before the 31st of December 1985.
4. This contract will terminate on the 31st of December 1985.
5. The ECC agrees to forward all materials produced by it between the 1st of January 1985 and 31st December 1985 to Development and Peace by the 31st December 1985.

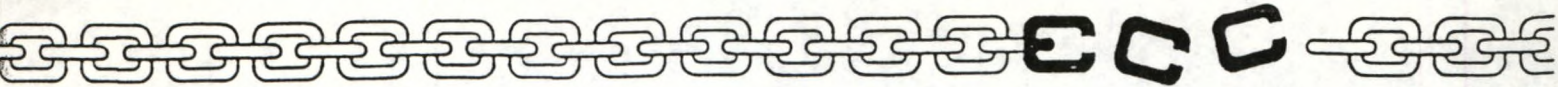

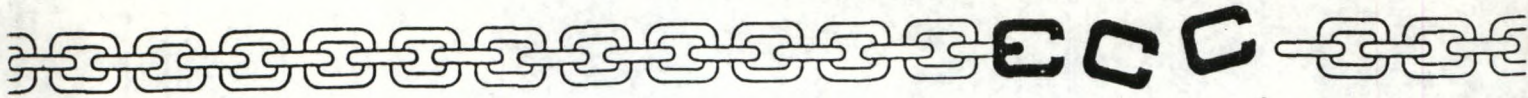
