Dear Sir.

I have been advised by Security Pelice Headquarters in Pretoria that a request made by me to visit Mr. Robert Schukwe on Robben Island has been refused.

While I realize that permission to visit Mr. Sebukwe is entirely within your discretion, I write to ask whether it is possible to reconsider the refusal, or else to ndvise me of the reasons for the refusal.

During last year, I was given permission to see Mr. Sobukve on six occasions. The first visit was for the purpose of conducting a newspaper interview, but the others were to camble me to interview Mr. Sobukve for the private research on which I am engaged, and to see him as a friend.

I did not make use of these later visits for newspaper purposes. Although I am at present again a full-time member of the "Rand Daily Mail", my aim in secking to see Mr. Sebukre now is purely private in that I am a friend of his. There is no question of my attempting to make use of any opportunity I may have of seeing him for newspaper purposes.

Your kindness in allowing me access last year to Mr. Sobukwe was greatly appreciated by both him and me. I trust that you will find it consible to recommider your refusal.
