The meeting took place in a comradely spirit as usual and there was no evidence of differing views or threats of resignations as projected by sections of the media.


ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERSI

The Department of Land and Environment Affairs under Dr Solly Skosana has been divided into two portfolios namely the Depart, ment of Environment Affairs under Dr. Solly Skosana and the Department of Land and Agricultural Affairs under Dr. Peter Mayende. Dr. Mayende is an Agroconomist who studied in Botswana and London and is currently a lecturer at the University of Transkei.

Dr. Mayende will address a major newsconference at the P.A.C. Readquarters on Thursday (4/2/93) to reveal the P.A.C. proposed Agricultural policy. The document was endorsed for discussion in the N.E.C. and dealt with the present structure of the agrarian sector, land reform strategy, redistribution, mechanisms for selecting beneficiarias, systems of tenure, state intervention various productive land activities, urban transformation, institutional framework for land reform and conservation.

THE REEIGNATION OF MR E.D. MOSENEKE:

The meeting noted the resignation of Adv. Moseneke from the N.E.C. and acknowledged his sterling contributions to the struggle. The N.E.C. accepted his reasons for resignation namely work and family pressure. We appreciated his offer to continue contributing his time and effort as a member of the party and we will contact him in that regard. The meeting decided not to appoint anybody in his vacant post.
