

groupings. G'town: problems with the front as committees of orgs change yearly. But good relations with orgs generally and with Sash in town. UCT: feel importance is not affiliation but concrete contact with organisations. Jhb: front does not exist, are having discussion on role of front. Affiliated to Five Freedoms Forum and Free the Children. Durban: no front as such. Have an organisational forum monthly. Durban campus: no front as such, but work closely with Nusas. Energy should be put into building links with organisations.

Our use of the term 'front' is incorrect. A front means a group of organisations coming together to establish popular unity. ECC was a front but is now an organisation. Concept of front needs to be expunged.

We need to be structuring relationships with organisations and must not be straightjacketed by only consulting with organisations in our front. Should get to other orgs during campaign to get them to endorse our demands around alternative service.

NC suggested that were orgs are participating in ECC business: "good and well". But where not, we must get support for organisations for our campaign set of demands. National workers to draw up set of demands and circulate to regions.

In future, we should not speak as "ECC - a front of 52 organisations", but rather "The ECC has support from 52 organisations".

d) Free the Children Alliance

FCA requested a ECC speaker to come to their conference. NC suggested that Jhb/Wits provide the speaker.

How we being politically effective?

Been good media exposure through issues + not specifically ECC. Lots of different + diverse pressure on government. ASP + Alt Service needs to push toward post Apartheid society. Objector movement has become powerful. Aims are reasonable with broad appeal. Aims of Alt Service can't just be dismissed by state. Activists are getting good understanding of strategy.

We call for Alt in context of ending conscription. Is alt service calls a cooption. ^{But} If legislation sound alt service is changed it will be a victory to ECC + there will still be other issues sound alt service to focus on.

Alt service is an interim demand, but it is also an alternative to ending conscription. Is there a hole in our argument? PFP's policy is more spelt out based on policy to be implemented when gain power while ECC's message is advanced on a moral level. At some stage should formulate policy on End to Conscription.

→ Could discuss it at conference next year + formulate policy on it based on research.

→ Other option would be to examine it thoughtfully looking at matters of principle.

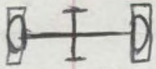

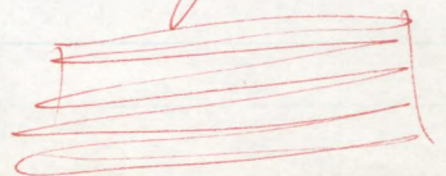


