LOONY town-hall Lefties were blasted yesterday for secretly trying to rename local landmarks in honour of black terrorists.

Labour councillors at Lambeth, South London, are ignoring public outrage and an 11,500-name protest petition in a bid to hustle through their ideas.

Streatham Baths could become the Mangaliso Sobukwe Pool after a dead African activist. Brockwell Park would be changed to Zephanie Mothopeng Park

in honour of an anti-apartheid leader. And Myatts Fields would be renamed Sharpurji Saklatvala Fields after Britain's first Communist MP.

Tory MP Peter Bruinvels yesterday slammed the plan as "outrageous."

Petition

He claimed: "The socialists are trying to buy the immigrant vote.

"They didn't ask the locals beforehand if they wanted the changes and it is a complete waste of taxpayers' money.

"No one can spell the new names, and I bet the Post Office won't be too

pleased, either."

Lambeth Council climbed down over a similar plan last year after thousands of people signed the protest petition.

But now they have resurrected the proposals and buried them deep in official minutes.

They have asked their Amenity Services Committee to find ways to "name new developments and rename existing amenity facilities after prominent black people."
