Women who are residing in the hostels also seem to be playing a role. Threatening people who pass,

Hostel dwellers in the family units are harassed to give money for deaths, contribute to those who have been arrested ^{also bullets + T-shirts until 1st time Jan 92} etc + they give because they fear for their safety. Also people are not allowed to move out.

At one stage electricity was cut off from the whole hostel except for where the police stay + counsellors switched it on again.

They would like us to ask diplomats to come. Patricia Masake 9882532 will be the organiser - to get residents to attend meeting.

Phone counsellors to ask what they are doing about what they are doing ~~with~~ about the violence + attacks on residents.

Residents discussed the difference in tactics of the police when residents are attacked. They say that the police are always there when the residents attack but are never there if it's the other way round.

One complaint was that when police come into the house they ask what party you belong to!

Security Police forces before rounded up the township
on the pretext of a search. This does not
happen but because the community is disorganised
it makes it easy for the attackers to come in.
He believes that they are not facing block on
black violence but rather an orchestrated ^{state} violence

the police are given the job to investigate themselves.
Have tried to speak to hostel.
The hostel had been empty & then after the
flood residence was on transit basis now
it would seem to be permanent.
People are now being kidnapped. But police

On 8th Feb at 5.46 they were sitting at home
hostel people came out. They began killing
looting. Youths came out & tried to defend them
Householders phoned police but they came after
the attack.

When police came they fired teargas at the
community who were trying to defend them
Police took T.V. etc in front of the community.
If anyone of the residents get injured police
leave them but hostel dwellers are helped.
She saw with her own eyes people getting out
of the caspers to loot. When they saw her watches
they fired shots at her. She believes if the police

were not heard the violence would ~~to~~ end
Her plea was for help
She mentioned that there were so many
people who had moved out of the houses.

In her home a grenade was found. she has now taken her family to another place for safety.

I saw police opening the gate they said the came to protect us but instead they side with the hostel dwellers.

Things are so bad that people have been told not to walk near the hostel since then police came into the township &

Friday . hostel people were going to attack us

May 1st workers day & everyone was at home.
There was an Inkatha rally that day.

When we are attacked we retaliate when we are attacked.

On Friday morning at about 7am the hostel dwellers came out of the hostel they moved along Mampeng Street. They attacked a shack they searched but we don't know what they were searching for.

They had guns but did not shoot at the time. & then they left.

There must have been + 200 of them.

They then went up the street & back to the hostels. when

The residents came out of their houses & attacked them by throwing stones.

* ~~Before the attack happened~~

Immediately when the residents attacked the hostel dwellers the police SAP & SADF came, until the residents attack the security forces were not seen.

They arrived in casspirs & private vehicles & riot squad armoured cars. & started firing teargas & rubber bullets & live ammunition into the community & made no attempt to disarm the hostel dwellers. & no attempt to disperse them.

They shot at the residents without warning. When we ran to our houses we were teargassed.

The SAP's vehicles were BFM 125B, BHL 105B & BHL 107B
CASSPIR 22 A SOLDIER gave a lift to 2 people who were shot & hospital

The residents took people who were wounded to the hospital. No attempt to do so was made by the police.

When the teller of this story visited the hospital to see how the wounded were he found them under police guard.

While we were visiting extra police arrived & because we felt insecure we left. One person died.

Yesterday they went to Robsonville Court & discovered that those charged are charged with public violence.

In the evening we barricaded the streets. From 9am - 12 the police were in our minds assessing the hostel dwellers because when we were attacked they did nothing to protect us. They on the other hand would continue teargassing & bid shot & live ammunition.

Weekends from Friday police in uniform come to the hostel at 4am and bring people whom we don't know & we don't know where they come from. During the week there are a few but from Thursday they bring them in but on Monday mornings they leave in the same way.

The comrades say they have spoken to hostel dwellers who have told them that whites had come to Umhlozi etc & were recruited by whites on the promise of a job. When they arrive they are given weapons & told to attack the residents & then they are given whites.

RUBY. MARUMU 2120 Moasha St Dobsonville

On the 28th or 29th April it was a Wednesday.
I was at Mawasha St. at about 2-4 pm
I was at the gate & 2 white men in
camouflage uniforms came & told me they
were taking me to the hostel.

They took me in a small yellow police
van. to Dobsonville Hostel.

They hooked & drove out & then left
me at a spot between the hostel & Fort
High School. They took a baton & assaulted
me on the back before leaving without
saying anything. This area is very dangerous
it is a no go area.

When they left I returned home by
foot. which was a 15 minute walk home.
They might have taken me because
I had been sitting near a barricade.

It was 12 midnight on ~~11th~~ ^{11th} April 1992. I heard 2 gun shots at my mother's house opposite from where I was sleeping. I looked through the window & saw plenty men (20-30) in overcoats & they started breaking the windows & doors. They went inside - switched on the lights & we saw them taking our fridge, stoves, kitchen unit, dining room suite, 2 TV's & everything in the house. We saw them taking the stuff into the hostel.

That same night we phoned the Dobsonville Police who said they "were too scared of those people to do anything". They referred us to Protea Police stations who gave us the very same answer.

The case number & list of items lost will be given to Peace Action to Ollie. The house he is at at present:

or we were told that we must go home & they would come

he looked back & saw policemen.

He tried to run away as he did a
white policeman in camouflage shot him.
He was hit many times down one side of
his body, in his hand 3 times & the one
finger is not functioning. I am not sure
whether the bullets were bird shot or live
ammunition. He was taken by the police in
a yellow car to Dobsonville Police Station.
He lost consciousness at the police station
& he regained his senses in Herathong
Hospital. He no longer had his shoes on.
He found he was under police guard.
He was transferred from the hospital to
Dobsonville Police Station on Monday 4/5/92.
On Tuesday he was taken to Roodepoort
to the Magistrates court at G Court. where
he was not formally charged & remanded
to the 19th May & Bail was refused.
He is in Kuyersdorp Prison.

ACTION

They have already spoken to Venetia re this
case check with her as to what has been
done.

On Friday ^{Moore} \pm 12pm people came to my house and told me that MBONGENI had been shot by the police. She ran to Mawashi St and he was already in the van. I couldn't talk to him at that stage as he was in the van. ^{Molife was a look-out}

I saw the police & the mothers confronting each other. They ^{the mothers} were shouting "why are you killing our kids!" It seems as if the target of the shootings were the youths. ^{dead on the 17th May.}

I was very scared at that time so I didn't stay for long. I went home ^{Friday night}.

Chairperson Residents Committee:

Since the problem we had with 32 battalions after trying to evict them from Phola Park. There are certain policemen harassing us so much so we cant sleep (2) Those unemployed seeking employment are unable to do so because especially at night they go around with a loud trailer saying the men should go out + fight.

Sometimes if you come back from work take ^{them} they are assaulted.

They have discovered that there is poison in the wees surrounding the camp. They cannot stand the smell of the substance especially the children. Some are hospitalized.

One man we are not sure after being shot if he is dead or alive.

They asked us to come to Phola Park ourselves to observe.

The other problem is that at the entry point at the camp they demand some form of ID if you haven't got it you are thrown into a cell. Some who gave their IDs had them torn up by the police.

Other problem is that the 3 ADF who should be protecting us are not, where do they turn to they now want them out + they will protect themselves. They have observed that they are the ones instigating the violence they must go

Trucks bring up in water & there are not allowed in, this forces them to get water from one of the rivers nearby. This puts them in trouble with the police.

School children are stopped from leaving the camp to attend school.

Yesterday one insisted going to school & was put in a car and only brought back later.

Residents meeting around these issues if seen they are tear gassed.

As a result they are confused & don't know how they are supposed to live in the camp.

Residents committee met with SADF. A senior member ~~said~~ ^{undertook} they would not go into the camp anymore. ^{HOWEVER, after} the meeting ~~happened~~ ^{was held} after they had ~~met~~ ^{met} someone ~~from the shack~~ ^{from the shack}. They were eye witnesses.

When they meet they are also fired on with rubber bullets.

When they first arrived the said they were looking for animals but it became evident this was not true because residents & women children are being threatened & harassed.

They don't know why the camp has been surrounded with barbed wire.

SADF go into the houses to search.

They arrived last Friday to put the wire but did not speak to any one about it.

^{Taxi hijacked} People coming home from work were abducted & taken to the hostel. ^{They are coded & those who are pregnant & sick are killed} They need to resolve the problem. Things went wrong they are not sure why things went wrong & they noticed the burning of cars etc but are not sure who was doing this.

Friday.

Shacks of people who were not there had their shacks raided doors & other furniture broken. The houses were sawshacked. Some instances poured paraffin into their food.

The child said that they had locked him up in a container. & released \pm 2:30 pm.

ABDUCTED PEOPLE. those taken into the hostel only found their corpses in the mortuary.

There are 9. It is still happening they are burying some - one on Saturday.

x SOLDIER BUSHOT what could have happened is the soldiers were coming in from opposite directions & they feel he could have been killed by one of their own colleagues.

± 10.15 pm. we were all asleep. We heard a noise outside when we investigated we saw a group of men. They were wearing ^{striped} head bands & I.F.P. T-shirts - all were wearing the same. 5 came into our house the rest came into the house. I cannot tell if they were all black as they broke the door down & came into the house & began breaking things in the dining room. I ~~was~~ ^{left} into the bedroom & the leader of the group came straight for me & stabbed me 3 times in my thigh with an assegai.

As he was stabbing me he said "these dogs must be killed!" He spoke Zulu & the others did not say anything but began stabbing my mother with spears.

When the one who had stabbed me went for my daughter (21) & started stabbing.

The others who had left the room came back & told him to come but he kept on stabbing my daughter saying "this dog must die".

When he was satisfied that she was dead he left. She was the mother of a 2 month old baby. ^{who they did not see} They left ~~the~~ my 3 year old child who was sleeping next to me.

* Maria was under the bed when she was attacked & the baby was behind her & they didn't see the baby. This attack happened in the dark & the stabbing took place indiscriminately stabbing without seeing what they were stabbing.

My mother is (89) Paulina & in hospital operated on her stomachs. We were taken to hospital by ambulance about 11.15. When first phoned they said they were busy the telephone Maria may have been saved if they had come earlier.

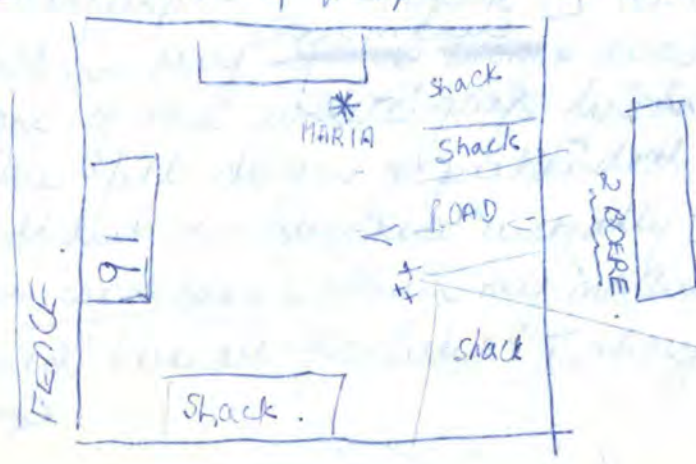

91 Joe Slovo Squatter Camp

Past 9 pm. my wife Maria ~~was~~ ^{8 months} was pregnant + I we were sleeping. I heard a woman + 2 children screaming. I went out of the house to investigate after waking up my wife. I saw 2 men beating up a woman + 2 children in the yard. I went near them + saw that ^{they had white head bands + saw} this was serious + was attacking her + saw a shining weapon which I thought was a pangas.

Behind them I saw 2 Boers, white men, in camouflage uniforms. They were outside the house + they had R1 rifles, they aimed the rifles at us. I + my wife ran away. We jumped through the fence. I left my wife + ran to the side + four shots were fired at me. My wife ^{unknown to me} ran back to near the blue shack in my yard + she was shot.

I ran until I got to a river, I went to Kosmacheerie. I remained there + heard lots of gunfire + I returned at dawn + found Maria lying dead next to the blue shack one bullet in ^{her} heart + the other in her arm. I don't know what happened ^{to the woman + 2 children}. There are many people who can testify to this.



KATHERINE RAMOLETSI 97 Joe Slovo Squatter

We had just gone to bed & we heard a noise from the next door shack. My mother woke up & went ^{to check the door} & woke up the young ^{black} girl boy & told him there was trouble & he should ^{hide} take my younger sister followed them & my other brother also woke up & followed them. There were 3 white people. They were wearing black overcoats & balaclavas, ^{I had guns.} I saw them myself as I was standing at the door. There were also about 4 black people. They were also wearing black overcoats & ^{striped} head bands across their foreheads.

When they saw Simon they ~~attacked him~~ ~~with axes~~ followed him to the young peoples hiding place. There they found my mother and the young people. They began stabbing my mother & brother. They did not stab the others. They then left the back way.

From the doorway I shouted "What is happening here!" They came towards me I quickly closed the door. They shouted for me to "come out" in Zulu but I didn't. [They were banging on the door.] They then left.

When my ^{sister in law} ~~brother's~~ sister was running away one of the white guys fired 2 shots at her. She fell down & pretended she was dead.

(and I didn't run because initially I thought it was the comrades). When my mother woke up she said "Here are the Zulus" I thought she was panicking
