punctually at 9.15am - we had breakfast
on the platform while the train was
not in - left Punctually on the DOT
of 10am - Sr Denise Anclaud had a
couple to herself - Sr Augustine & Sr
Dorothy the most snappy - got a packet
of sandwiches of egg & tomato each for
"woolies" - then came to Marine
Glen - No Tea place open - closed
between 12 & 2pm! So we sat down on
pious lunch - which we had sitting
at a table overlooking the sea - the still
sat on & said office wide letters -
After 2pm - had some tea - & at 3pm walked
to the "line" towards the Rock home!!

So much for that! Went Back 'one draw out
just at the Aqueduct, one came in so
we sat on the seat & did "our reading" -

the one came in at 4.45 - To help
us on - we each had Two fried eggs for

Tuesday, May 21 A most perfect day again - IN
every way Mild & Sunny - with a flat
Sea, except for the usual shore waves not a
breath of wind. MAT at 8 before 5 Jan -
then to Shelling Beach - (Mr. Clewley called
just before we went to say he would bring soup
& Sp.). We got a lift by 3 very nice
female - Swiss - German - & Belgian -
& a lift back by a couple & 2 children
from Grolenkom on holiday with her mother.
We wrote letters - read the newspaper & snoozed
So Dorothy peddled 7 of us - letters when we

arrived back - found a note under the door
of 2 packets of Extra strong Peppermint for
Aunt Stumblee who had called to say goodbye to
L. Davolter - her to the library to return
5 books & buy cheese & oranges -
L. J. A's early night.

Wednesday May 22. A very lovely day again.

Fr Campbell collected us at 6.20 for
Mess of All Saints. On the way back called

at the Butcher in Avon & gave for
