If I recall it correctly, last year your Education Fund generously provided for his 1970 Fees (R130) and books (R66), and for his 1971 fees (R160). You will be glad to know that he passed his examinations last year and is now enrolled for the second year of study. Also, as you will have seen in the Press, his banning orders have been relaxed to enable him to serve his legal articles.

I have a list of the books which he needs for this year, but have not yet had a chance to price them -- I shall be doing so this week. But in the meantime, can you let me know whether the figures set out above are correct, and if so, whether it will be possible to get further help for his books for this year?
