The responsibility for the provision of school buildings is divided between the Council for lower primany schools (i.e. up to Std. II) and the Bantu Education Department for higher primary and secondary schools. Iower primary schools have been built by the Council, containing classrooms in the last years, each at an average cost of R12,000 per school of 10 classrooms. This includes ancillary buildings such as offices, storerooms and toilets. This ceiling of $\mathrm{Rl}, 200$ per classroom was reasonable until recently but the steep rise in the cost of materials and labour now makes it difficult to achieve.

The majority of parents in Soweto make a direct contribution to the capital cost of building these schools as an amount of 18 c is included in the monthly house rental.

Only in the older schemes i.e. prior to 19 , where in the majority of cases school buildings had already been provided is no 18c levy made.
