REPORT: A Report was tendered on the Joint Executive meeting held recently and on the COP held in Kliptown. A lengthy discussion followed.

- DECISIONS:
- (1) It was decided that a copy of the Joint Ex. Report be given to the Secretary.
 - (2) The Natal Action Committee to be called from now on as Natal Consultative Committee.
 - *(3) A special statement from the ANC and NIC and COD be issued at the earliest supporting the Freedom Charter.
 - (4) Preparations must be made for the collection of 150,000 Signatures in Natal.
 - (5) A report back on the COP by means of mass Meetings must be arranged.
 - (6) A joint meeting of the ANC, NIC & COD Executive be arranged to discuss the Decisions Joint Executive Meeting.

FREEDOM CHARTER:

The NIC purchased 2000 Freedom Charters for 25.C.O.

FINANCE: A Financial statement was presented and discussed. The urgency of settling certain debts was emphasised.

It was decided that immediate arrangements be made to raise finance. This also to be put before the Joint Executive Meeting (Natal).
