* We want to make a songsheet - our very own ECC edition - no sloppy venture this - so please follow the instructions :

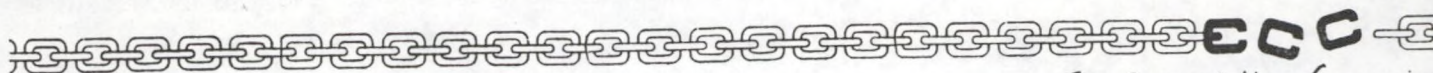
- Type the songs on A4 paper
