My dear Eulalie,

I have just returned from a three week visit to the Rhodesias. I intended writing to you before going, but can't remember if I did so. So please accept my apologies if this letter is merely a repetition of an earlier one.

I have arranged for Mrs. Sebukwe to visit Cape Town again in order to see Bob. When I last saw her, some weeks ago, she planned to travel down in June. I have not been able to contact her since returning so am unsure as to whether she has in fact gone. In any event, I told her to contact you when she reached Cape Town and assured her that you would be happy to give her any assistance that might need. She intends to stay at the Tafelberg Hotel because of the difficulties she had last year at Langa.

She should have enough money to cover her expenses. But if she runs short, could you telegraph me immediately and I will send down whatever additional amount is required.

In a letter I received yesterday, from Bob, he told me that the arrangement for delivering fruit to him is working out well. You might care to convey this to those concerned. He also mentioned that Father Flexmoor had been to see him and had promised to come monthly.

I hope you are keeping well.
