"... the development of a sense of South African national unity, based on the equality of the Afrikaans- and English-speaking sections of the community, coupled with the recognition and appreciation by either section of the distinctive cultural heritage of the other.

Equal language rights in respect of the Afrikaans-speaking and English-speaking sections of the population shall in practice, in so far as the State is concerned therewith, be exercised and maintained in all respects, and in every part of our national life within the Union."

- From our "Programme of Principles", 1934. -

We have no time for petty squabbling, together we must solve far more serious problems and together we must take the responsibility for our decisions.

We will build a bilingual nation. Every encouragement and opportunity will be given to each language group to know and appreciate the other's achievements, so that the spiritual and material attainments of both will be the common heritage of all. The aim to share our heritage must begin in the schools. (See also page 11).

Can we ever forgive the present Government for discouraging immigration in the past? Simple common sense demands that we maintain our numbers as best we can and do not fall behind.

What Australia and Canada have done, we can do, too.

It is United Party policy to increase our White population as rapidly as economic conditions allow by immigration, and to encourage the increase of our settled White population through children's allowances, tax rebates and the like. In carrying out its immigration policy, the United Party will pay due regard to the maintenance of the South African way of life.

THIS IS OUR NON-WHITE POLICY

Here are the main points of the United Party's race policy, adopted by its Bloemfontein Congress in August, 1961. The policy was described by Sir De Villiers Graaff as "an ordered advance to Race Federation."

The basic principle on which the policy rests are:-

BASIC PRINCIPLES.

- A willingness to share the fruits of Western civilisation;
- Maintenance of White leadership;
- Respect for individual dignity, regardless of race; and
- Inter-race consultation at all levels.

IMMEDIATE STEPS.

The immediate steps that the United Party will take to relieve racial tension will be:—

- Review of all laws infringing the individual dignity of non-Whites;
- Humane administration of laws like the Group Areas Act and the Pass Laws.
- The recognition of a responsible Urban Native middle class as a bulwark against agitators; they will enjoy pass exemptions, controlled home ownership and undisturbed home life.
- Encouragement of the rapid development of the Reserves with, inter alia, the aid of White skill, initiative and capital.
- Development of elected local government institutions for all Natives. Representation in Parliament by White M.P.'s and Senators elected on a Separate Roll.

Indians

are recognised as a permanent part of the population. They will be given relief from those economic provisions of the Group Areas Act

which interfere with their traditional means of livelihood.

Talks will be held with Indian leaders to determine their future political status.

Coloureds

will be accepted as part of the Western group and restored to the Common Roll with the right to sit in Parliament, if so elected.

Job reservation will be replaced by the rate for the job, and there will be drastic revision of the Group Areas Act.

THE ULTIMATE GOAL IS A RACE FEDERATION – the United Party's alternative to Bantustan apartheid:

South Africa will be ruled by a sovereign central Parliament; Each racial group will have a defined share in this government, and basic rights of individuals, groups and areas will be entrenched constitutionally.

The federation will primarily be one of races — not territories. Where possible, predominantly white and predominantly black areas will for administrative purposes, be grouped separately as political units.

The UNITED PARTY pledges itself not to introduce any changes in the political representation of non-Whites beyond its present accepted and published policy without a clear and specific mandate from the electorate by way of a REFERENDUM or a GENERAL ELECTION.

80% of our labour force is non-European. - It is common sense that it should be better trained so as to increase to productivity which will inevitably result in a higher standard of living for both Europeans and non-Europeans.

The United Party will do everything possible to protect all workers and to faster harmonious race relations in industry.

What about Native Trade Unions?

Owing to the fact that the Native labour force consists of different classes of labour, varying from the primitive, unskilled group to semiskilled and skilled workers, the problem of their collective representation cannot be resolved by one method only, and will have to be determined only after consultation with responsible leaders of existing Trade Unions and organised management.


