{The children are well. Ngoetse had an attack of measles (some time back), but she is well now.

Chief,

I received your letter and Chief Joshua's. Minchin has sent the Demand of Bento which you made. Please sir, please go to him and tell him that Chief Joshua is not here and that he must wait; he (the chief) will come and fix up the matter. Before going to him, please ask Mr Maseng if Chief Joshua has paid or not.

Please sir, you know how hard it will go with me if they can issue Summons especially if Mr Mojanaga is there.

Please sir, help in this regard.
