LEANDRA ACTION COMMITTEE

We act on behalf of the Leandra Action Committee (The Committee) a body representing the Community of Leandra.

We have been consulted with a view to recording our client's grave concern at recent reports in the press carrying statements made by your Chief Director, Mr Jonker, stating that over 18, 000 residents of Leandra are to be resettled in the homeland of Kwadedele.

We are further instructed record that at a Public Meeting held on 15 January 1984, at which members of the local Community Council were present, the residents mandated the Committee to approach your Board with a view of discussing the intentions of the Board to remove almost the entire Community from Leandra, as well as the following issues:

1. The building of the new township where accomodation is being made available for about 700 families and the quality of the homes being built.
2. The graveyard in the township, which the Board is thinking of digging up.
3. The Board's response to the Community's requests contained in the minutes of the meeting held on the 5 June 1983.

We are given to understand that the Board has undertaken to meet with the Committee to discuss the above issues but this has not materialised.

On behalf of the Committee we therefore would be pleased if you could inform us of the Board's intention in regard to the Communities future.


