His father, Mr Werner Dieter Roettgers-Schulte (45), was given the sad news by close friends, Mr and Mrs Ronnie Lund, on Saturday night when he and his wife returned from a tennis match at Pietersburg.

Paul had been an only son and the eldest of three children.

"They were devastated mer decided to fly phone his wife Lourina from the airport, but never did. We got worried, but could do nothing."

"We decided to wait for his arrival at about 8 pm in Cape Town, where people were to meet him for the trip to Hermanus. He did not arrive there either and we alerted the police.

"Later in the evening the police phoned to say he had been found."

A motorist had found Mr Roettgers-Schulte seriously wounded on a deserted dirt road between Rust de Winter and Hammanskraal.

He had bullet wounds in his head and stomach and died on the way to the hospital at Hammanskraal.
