



NOTICE IN TERMS OF SECTION FIVE OF THE  
SUPPRESSION OF COMMUNISM ACT, 1950  
(ACT NO. 44 OF 1950), AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS your name appears on the list in the custody  
of the officer referred to in section eight of the  
abovementioned Act;

NOW THEREFORE, I, CHARLES ROBBERTS SWART, ~~in my~~  
capacity as Minister of Justice for the Union of South  
Africa, by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by  
section five of the Suppression of Communism Act, 1950  
(Act No. 44 of 1950), as amended, do hereby direct you:

(a) To resign within a period of thirty days as  
from the date of this notice as an office-bearer,  
officer and member of the South African Society  
for Peace and Friendship with the U.S.S.R. and  
the Transvaal Peace Council, not again to become  
an office-bearer, officer or member of either of  
the said organisations and not to take part in  
their activities; and

(b) not to become an office-bearer, officer or member  
and not to take part in the activities of any of  
the undermentioned organisations:-

1. "African National Congress".
2. "African National Congress Youth League".
3. "South African Indian Congress".
4. "Natal Indian Congress".
5. "Transvaal Indian Congress".
6. "Transvaal Indian Youth Congress".
7. "Congress of Democrats" or "South African  
Peoples' Congress".
8. South African Peace Movement.

NOTICE IN TERMS OF SECTION NINE  
OF THE SUPPRESSION OF COMMUNISM ACT, 1950  
(ACT NO. 44 OF 1950), AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS in my opinion there is reason to believe that the achievement of the objects of communism would be furthered if you were to attend any gathering in any place within the Union of South Africa.

NOW THEREFORE, I, CHARLES ROBBERTS SWART, in my capacity as Minister of Justice for the Union of South Africa, by virtue of the powers conferred upon me by section nine of the Suppression of Communism Act, 1950 (Act No. 44 of 1950), as amended, do hereby prohibit you from attending, during a period of two years as from the date that this notice is delivered or tendered to you, any gathering in any place within the Union of South Africa.
