And whereas the RHodesia Railways Ltd uas applied for a grantof a certaj portion of land known as "tue Railway Strip", sithate in the area known as the Barolong Farmsin the Bechianaland Protectorate:
 empoweredto make a grant threof to the Rhodesia Rallways Ltd their successors or assigns;

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by virtue and in exceroise of the powers by the Foreign Jurisdiotion Act, 1890, or otherwise in His Majesty vested, is pleased by and with the advice of his Privy Council to order, and it is hereby ordered as folluws:-

1. The portion of land known as the Railway Strip in extent 154 morgen and 69 square roods situate in twe area known as tue Barolong Farms in the Bechuanaland Protectorate, bounded on the north by Glaisdale, on the south by Ramatlinabama's Kuil, and on the east and west by the Barolong Farms, as more fully appears from the sub-divisional diagram signed by the Resident Commissioner of the Becuranaland Protectorate, and deposited with t山e Registrar of Deedeof the Protectorate, is Lereby to be vested in His Majesty.
for Soutu Africa
2. The High Comissioner/is nereby empowered to grant tue said land to to the Rhodesia Railways Ltd on suan terms and conditions, and subject tosuch provision as to reversion of tue saゅd land to the Crown in the event of the railway ceasing to be operated thereon, as te shall think fit, provided that such grant shail not be made until the High Commissioner is satisfied twat the Rhodesia Railways Lijmted was erected a suitable fenceon the east and west sides of tue said strip.
3. Tuis order may be ofted as" The Bechuanaland Proptotanate (Railway Lands) Order-in-Counail, 1922.
4. His Majesty may at any time addto, alter or amend tiais order.
