You are congratulated on gaining the honour of representing your province. As a representative of your province or centre you have responsibilities as well as the honour. You have responsibilities to your association (SASSA) your home union, your school and last, but most important, you have a responsibility towards yourself.

The SASSSA has been established to:-

- (a) promote sport;
- (b) give students the opportunity of meeting students from other parts of our country;
- (c) give you the chance of learning how other children live; what their jobs and interests are and what their surrounds are like;
- (d) teach you that there are no differences when you take the trouble of looking at people and understanding them.

As a PLAYER you must:-

DEPARTURE OF TEAMS

Rules Governing SASSSA Rugby Tournaments

- I Registration and entry as per rules governing tournaments in general.
- 2 The tournament shall be held preferably during the Michaelmas vacation.
- 3 (a) Each participating unit shall be permitted to enter only one team per weight division.
 - (b) The weight division shall be (i) Open; (ii) 62,1 Kg and Under; (iii) 54,5 Kg and Under; (iv) 45,36 Kg and Under.
 - (c) A unit shall be permitted to register not more than TWENTY players per weight group.
- 4 Players shall be weighed, without boots, just before the start of play. A team list, signed by the manager of the team participating, shall be handed to the referee before the commencement of a match.
- 5 All matches shall be played according to the rules of the game as laid down by the International Rugby Football Board, except for those specifically contained herein.
- 6 (a) All players shall be uniformly attired.
 - (b) A player shall not wear dangerous projections such as buckles or rings. Any studs on his boots must be of leather, rubber or any approved material and securely fastened to the boots.
 - (c) The referee shall have full power to decide before or during a game, whether any part of player's dress, including boots and projections thereon, is dangerous and shall order such player to remove same and not allow him to take further part in the match until such removal.
- 7 The duration of matches shall be as follows:-
 - (a) Two periods of thirty-five minutes each in the open and 61,2Kg division.
 - (b) Two periods of thirty minutes each in the lighter division.
 - (c) There shall be an interval of not more than 5 minutes between each half of the match.
- 8 The names of at least TWO referees from each participating unit shall be submitted to the convenor of the tournament fourteen days before the commencing date of the tournament. The said referees must be acquainted with the rules governing the game, shall be suitable attired and may be called upon to act as touch judges. The touch judges shall use flags.
- 9 The Tournament shall be played on the league system, in sections if necessary,
- 10 In each match played two points shall be awarded for a win and one for a draw. Where two or more units score an equal number of points at the end of the tournament, the team scoring the highest number of tries shall be declared winners; the points against, shall decide the winning unit. Should there be competition in more than one weight division the total number of points scored by each unit's teams participating in the various divisions shall determine the champions.
- 11 The grounds on which the matches are played shall conform to the requirements set out by the laws of Rugby Football and the organising committee together with the managers of participating units shall have the right to inspect the grounds to determine whether matches shall be played on a particular ground.

RULES-GOVERNING SASSSA NETBALL TOURNAMENTS

- I Registration and Entries as per Rules Governing S.A.S.S.S.A. Tournaments in General.
- 2 The Tournament shall be held preferably during the Michaelmas Vacation.
- 3 Each unit shall be permitted to register not more than TEN players per age group.
- 4 All matches shall be played according to the laws of the game as set down by the International Federation of Women's Basketball and Netball Association, and adopted by the South African Women's Netball Association.
- 5 Matches shall be played on the league system, in sections where possible.
- 6 All players shall be uniformly dressed.
- 7 No jewellery, such as rings, earrings, hairslides and bangles shall be worn by players.
- 8 All players shall wear sandshoes for matches.
- 9 Each unit shall register at least TWO umpires.
- 10 When umpiring a match, umpires shall have full powers to decide whether a player is eligible in terms of rules 6, 7 and 8.
- 11 The duration of matches shall be as follows:
 (a) Under 15—15 minutes a side mith 5 minutes interval.
 (b) Under 17—20 munites a side with 5 minutes interval and Open.
- 12 At each match played an official score-keeper and a time-keeper shall be appointed.
- 13 The Netball courts must conform to the requirements of the official rules of the International Federation of Women's Basketball and Netball Association.
- 14 A meeting of umpires shall be held before the tournament commences.

Rules Governing SASSSA Table Tennis Tournaments

- I Registration and entry shall be as per rules governing S.A.S.S.S.A. tournaments in general.
- 2 (i) Each unit shall be permitted to enter only one team or only one per age division.
 - Each participating unit shall register 4 boys and 3 girls of whom 3 boys and 2 girls shall participate in any one match. No girl may play in more than 2 matches.
- 3 (i) The tournament shall be played on the league system.
 - (ii) Each fixture shall consist of 9 matches viz: 5 boys singles; I girls singles; I boys doubles; I mixed doubles;
 I girls doubles.
 - (iii) On a prescribed players' list the three boys and the two girls from the team shall register as A, B, C, D, E in that order and the three boys and the two girls from the other team shall register as V, W, X. Y. Z in that order.
- 4 The order of play shall be as follows:-

AB vs. VW	
DE vs. YZ	
B vs. V	
A vs. W	
CE vs. XZ	E=Girl.
	DE vs. YZ B vs. V A vs. W

5 Each match shall be decided on the best of three vantage sets.

- 6 A player participating in two consecutive matches shall be entitled to a rest of not more than 15 minutes between the matches.
- 7 There shall be no rest period in any one three set match.
- 8 Each fixture shall carry 8 points, one for each match played.
- 9 Each fixture shall be complete only after all 8 matches have been played.
- 10 No match or game shall be surrendered without the permission of the chief referee and without valid reason.
- 11 The organising unit shall appoint a chief referee for the tournament and one for each table.
- 12 The chief referee's decision on all matters pertaining to the tournament shall be final.
- 13 Each team shall, before the commencement of the days' fixtures hand in its teamlist to the chief referee after which the chief refereë shall arrange the programme of matches on a prescribed form.
- 14 The chief referee shall appoint all umpires.
- 15 Except for these rules the game shall be played in accordance with the rules as set out by the International Table Tennis Federation.


