Resolution passed at 1983 SACC National Conference.

"Believing that this society is based on the heresy of apartheid, and that the war being waged by South Africa is in defence of an unjust system, this National Conference of the SACC:

- 15.1. Declares that this is an unjust war and that participation is not in keeping with the Christian faith;
- 15.2. Calls on the Churches to educate their members on the serious implications for Christians of participating in defence of an evil system;
- 15.3. Calls on the SACC to convene a consultation of the Churches on militarisation with a view to setting up a programme to combat militarisation which will -
  - a) educate Christians at a grassroots level on the consequences of the increasing militarisation of South African society;
  - b) work out alternatives;
  - c) form and encourage support groups for those refusing to do military service;
