My Dear Sefetopi

26.4.1921

It is sometime now since I received your letter, but I have had so very little time to myself that I could not answer as soon as I would have liked. I went to Kanye at the end of last month. That was my first visit to the Bangwaketse capital & I can assure you that I enjoyed the trip immensely. I went by motor-car with Mr Rowland & we spent two days there. The Bangwaketse received me shoulder-high, and were very anxious that I should go and practise among them, but of course that idea I do not as yet entertain. I may go up there when the Barolong get tired of me or become unwilling to pay "head cash".

On the 17<sup>th</sup> May I went to Makgabana & Madibi with some friends here - Mrs Hommel, Miss Hommel, Mrs Bosch and her 2 children. We left Mafoeking at Eper by cart and four horses - Mr Moton Leinana being travelling manager

It was a fine moonlight night. We sang  
 and ate all along the way & got to  
 Makgabano at 10.30, woke up every body &  
 made a bon-fire & tea flowed like water.  
 It was a regular picnic - when you consider  
 that in the morning a goat & a cow was  
 was killed - the former for the visitors. ~~The~~

I am kept pretty busy. I have opened  
 a Surgery in town for the convenience of  
 the Indian & colored population

Every body is keeping well.
