1927 Brought up about 6 PM and the coffin placed in the little cloister leading into Chapel. The two standard lights were placed at the head & a crucifix. Vespers of the Dead were said directly after Vespers for the day.

July 26 A plain Requiem was said at 7.15. Followed by the Absolutions of the Dead with incense & Holy Water. The funeral took place about 10.00. Wentoby & the native boys ~~escorted~~ were Beavers Superior, Sr Christian & Sr Irene came to the funeral, & Mrs Gordon returned New York afterwards. The Bishop of Pretoria confirmed 9 of our girls in Chapel at 3.30.

29 The Chaplain came at 5.30 to hear Sister's Confession.

30 The Rev. Mother was communicated from the Tabernacle & at the Cottage before Mass.

31 7<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Trinity Sung Mass. Other services as usual.

203 No Mass on either day because so many Sisters were ill, & two in quarantine with measles. The Chaplain gave an instruction at Everyway but the Hursey girls could not attend. Feast of the Transfiguration. Plain Mass.
