Billy started measles + was taken to Hospital at 3 p.m. Sister Edith Aidan in Retreat. Solemn Evesing + Sermon. 6-15 p.m.

with Mother being her Profession Day.

Mary also in bed all day her cold very
heavy. At 2 p.m. Miss Wendon drove Mother
& Sister Ethel Irene into Boston. Mother

Meeting & to stay the night. Sister Ethel
Irene did shopping & returned at 6 p.m.
bringing back with her Sister Eudora &
Sister Dorothy Joan for Retreat. Sister E.
Irene took the Girls for class.
