FUNCTIONS

Wits Function Services are situated on the ground floor of the Student Union Building, University Drive, East Campus (opposite Sunnyside Residence).

FUNCTION ROOMS

Functions are catered for in our own air-conditioned Function Rooms alongside the Main Dining Room in the Student Union Building and are fully equipped and capable of accommodating parties from 6 to 180 in four separate function areas.

BOZZOLI SPORTS CENTRE HALL

The Bozzoli Sports Centre Hall is suitable for larger parties of up to 250 seated, including a dance floor.

CAFETERIA - STUDENT UNION BUILDING

The Cafeteria area on the upper ground level in the Student Union Building can be utilised for even larger functions of up to 1000 and more.

For example, we have successfully catered several times for the District Grand Lodge of the Transvaal - a formal dinner for ± 1200 guests - in this area. We have also catered for large company Christmas parties/dinner dances for 500/700 people.

FUNCTIONS AT OTHER VENUES ON CAMPUS

A comprehensive assortment of cocktail snacks and a complete bar service are also available, either for delivery or fully serviced, at any venue on campus.

CARDINAL PAULO ARNS - ARCHIBISHOP OF SAO PAULO.

Cardinal Paulo Evaristo Arns - recognised internationally for his human rights campaigns during 20 years of military rule in Brazil - has been invited to South Africa.

He will be speaking to Catholics in this Diocese on Saturday, 29th June, 1985.

ANTI- REPRESSION:

In 1971 the Cardinal sprang to prominance at the height of a wave of repression in Brazil during which two diocesan priests were arrested and brutally tortured.

Cardinal Arns called a meeting of all the priests in his Archdioces (the biggest in the world) to discuss the issue of torture. From the meeting came a strongly worded document which clearly defin ed the difference between social work and subversion, and outlined the church's position on social justice. Since then the cardinal has been subject to campaigns of harrassment by the military.

NEWSPAPER:

He founded the newspaper, "O Sao Paulo", the largest Catholic paper in the country. The government censored this paper and shut down his radio station which has broadcast educational information.

BASIC CHRISTIAN COMMUNITIES:

From 1973 he has worked with the Basic Christian Communities which are small groups of Christians who work out ways of improving their lives.

CATHOLIC PROTEST:

In 1975, over 8 000 Catholics defied military seizure of Sao Paulo by attending a mass called by Cardinal Arns after the death by torture of a respected journalist, Vladimir Hertzog.

SUPPORT FOR WORKERS:

In 1976 he sent out a pastoral letter condemning the plight of city workers. He was declared by the military to be the main person behing the country's labour opposition.

In 1979 he supported the first major strike in Brazil by declaring that the right to strike was fundamental to a democratic society. He also led the funeral of two worker leaders killed by police which was transformed into a major protest demonstration. He is still involved in the training of worker leaders for the struggle for improved conditions of work.

ON THE CHURCH AND POLITICS:

"For the church", says the Cardinal "politics is everything that has to do with the well being of the majority of the people. It means the poor must organise to act as a group to defend their rights. It means they must create intermediary organisations, such as unions, to be able to react collectively. It means Christian lay people must participate in party politics defending the rights of the majority."

How are you? I am alright although back here we are still recovering from the shock of Chris Hani's cold blooded assassination and there is also a sense of sadness at the death of O. R.

Since the beginning of April I have been working for the End Conscription Campaign (although I am still involved with Peace Action as a volunteer). In July ECC is intending to hold a Peace Festival to celebrate its 10th anniversary. I have been employed as the festival organiser.

This letter is a very special appeal to the Dutch Anti-Apartheid movement to help us with funding for the festival. The festival is being held to celebrate ECC's 10th anniversary but will focus on a wide range of issues related to building peace in South Africa.

The aim of this festival will be to provide a forum where members of organisations and the public can discuss ways to continue working for peace in South Africa. We have invited Nelson Mandela to deliver the opening address at the festival.

We will be discussing a wide range of issues, such as the idea, put forward by Chris Hani just before his death, that the Self Defence Units be transformed into a Peace Corps. Other issues which we will be discussing include the question of a peace keeping force, community based peace initiatives and the transformation of the armed forces.

We hope to be able to finance transport and registration costs for people from communities, such as the Vaal, to be able to attend. The festival is intended to fall on the weekend of the 16th, 17th, and 18th of July.
