SECURITY INSTRUCTIONS FOR TRAVEL TO NATIONAL CONFERENCE

TO: National Contact Reps.

These instructions are confidential and should be destroyed after you have read and memorised them. The logistical arrangements should, where possible, be carried out by you alone. Where anyone else is brought in to help (e.g. in hiring cars) you should take care that the person is absolutely trusted and that they are only told what they need to know.

- 1.) You will be told your initial destination point. At no time should anyone else be given this information.
- 2.) All members should be informed that they may not take radios, tape decks, or any device that could conceal a transmitter. Members should be informed that there will be baggage searches.
- 3.) The arrangements for leaving town should include at least two, and preferably three, initial meeting points. And the final meeting
- 4.) Hired mini-buses or any other <u>safe</u> transport should be waiting at the final meeting venue. At this point there should be a quick search of baggage and you should leave without delay.
- 5.) All ECC related material that is being taken to the conference should be in one suitcase in one combi (this goes for note-books, diaries etc.)
- 6.) Each group should be clear on an alibi (possibly a christian conference) and they should dress accordingly and be carrying appropriate literature.
- 7.) The vehicles should meet at checkpoints that you will give the drivers. They should only be told of the next checkpoint so that they are only sure of the general final destination at the last checkpoint.
- 8.) No-one may use a phone at any time, nor should there ever be a situation where an individual may use a phone unobserved.
- 9.) If you arrive at the destination point you have been given early, then go elsewhere an wait (preferably in a park) and go to the meeting

point at the exact time.

- 10.) Every effort should be made not to arrive late. If there is some unavoidable mishap, and you are late, then arrive at the meeting point exactly one hour, or exactly two hours after the time you will be given. If you are any later than this, you will have to return to your centre. It is suggested that you leave a considerable margin for error/mechanical failure etc.
- 11.) You will be informed as to the items members need bring, but at this stage it seems we may need sleeping bags.
