UNIVERSALS COUNTER PROPOSED THAT THE SUBSEQUENT DECISION OF THE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE ON THE 13TH AUGUST BE CONFIRMED AND RATIFIED BY THE GENERAL MEETING, DOORNFONTEN UNITED SECONDED THIS PROPOSAL:





6) JUVENTUS WERE ADVISED THAT AFTER THEIR MATCH BRICKS WERE THROWN ON THE OFFICE ROOF. THIS HAS NEVER EVER HAPPENED IN THE PAST. THEY WERE REQUESTED TO INVESTIGATE ESTABLISH WHO THE CULPRITS ARE AND FURNISH THE NAMES AT THE NEXT MEETING.
