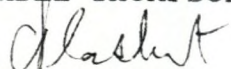
re: **STATEMENT OF ACCOUNT TO THE JACARANDA TRUST**

We refer to the above and attach our statement of account for legal work done in respect of conscription for the period 1 June 1991 to 30 June 1991. We hope that it meets with your approval. The account has been submitted to you on the advice of Nan Cross and Mandy Taylor who informed us that an amount of money had been set aside for legal fees.

During this period we completed our outstanding trial work. We attended court on 24 June 1991 when charges were withdrawn against Clyde Wynter and Wayne Boshier for failing to report for military service. We also represented other conscientious objectors in respect of applications for exemption and deferment.

Finally we were instructed by fourteen religious objectors currently performing community service. We drafted representations on their behalf to the Gleeson Committee which addressed the question of the treatment of religious objectors and recommended various reforms to the system.

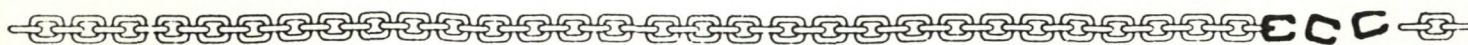

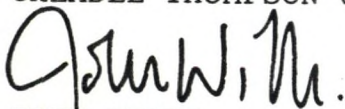
re: **STATEMENT OF ACCOUNT TO THE JACARANDA TRUST**

We refer to the above and attach our statement of account for legal work done in respect of conscription for the period 1 July 1991 to 30 July 1991. We hope that it meets with your approval.

This period was marked by ongoing advice to various conscriptees. The case of David Jooste was quite interesting in that he was called up for service in terms of the Police Act in that he had not attended camps which he was liable to do with the Police Force since 1986. The Police had therefor issued a warrant for his arrest which we successfully managed to quash. We note that David Jooste has been a prominent anti-apartheid activist during the 1980's and was under threat of detention from June 1986 onwards.

We have not heard anything from the Gleeson Committee and will be following them up during the course of this month.

We refer to the above and attach our statement of account for the legal work done in respect of conscription matters for the above period. We hope that it meets with your approval.

This period was marked by an increase in the number of conscripts that sought legal advice. In terms of previous discussions with yourselves we have charged most of our clients directly. However, in matters where very short telephonic advice was given we have charged yourselves.

In all of these cases the matters were referred either by ECC or COSG.

We have changed the format of the account in respect of clients who are paying a contribution of their legal fees. You will see that there are separate accounts for Mr Ian Burns, Mr I J Medak, Mr A F Barnard, Mr A Gordon and Mr John de Wet.

You will see from the attached schedule the contribution that will be paid by these clients, therefore you are only responsible for the remaining amount. In most of the cases it is a 50/50 arrangement.

We see the period under account as having been a particularly successful one in terms of which we received deferment for all

the applications which we put forward and, in addition, we were granted three applications for total exemptions. The case of Alan Victor Gordon is one such case. There was another case which was paid directly by client, a person by the name of Edi Cappialati and the Wolfson application which we accounted for previously.

We also emphasise that in the matters where we undertook to subsidise from ECC the matters were either important to the anti-conscription movement as a whole and/or the individual applicants were listed conscientious objectors.
