- 4. Players shall wear white tennis clothing.
- 5. Saturdays play will commence at 2p.m. Sunday play will commence at 8:00 a.m.
- 6. Players absent when called upon to play at any time will render themselves liable to disqualification.
- 7. The Eastern Transvaal Tournament Committee reserves the right to restrict or refuse entries, and to hold a qualifying competition or competitions as may be necessary. Entries will be ignored without notification, unless accompanied by full amount of fees due. Fees sent for entries subsequently rejected will be refunded.
- 8. All participants will be required to umpire or act as linesmen for all games.
