I am directed to inform you that the Reverend S. Carter has forwarded the following notices of motion and notices of question for discussion at the next meeting of the Advisory Board to be held on the 16th. September 1937:-

"That this Board considers it is the imperative duty of the Provincial Administration to press upon the Union Government the urgent necessity of restoring the deductions made from the Native teachers salaries during the years 1931, 1932, 1933 1934 by an extra grant from the Consolidated Revenue Fund (e.g. Act 46 of 1925); and this Board humbly requests that such an amount is placed on the Draft Estimates of this Provincial Administration which are to be submitted to the Secretary for Native Affairs before November 1st. 1937.

Notice of questions:

1. Is it not advisable that official letters to the circuit Inspectors should be forwarded on to them by post when they are away from their office.
2. Is it not advisable to reduce the routine work of teachers by using the daily attendance register as a school fees record book, and would not the Department authorise this as soon as possible?"

Sir,

I am directed to forward herewith the following draft
 notices of motion which the Reverend S. Carter proposes to move
 at the next meeting of the Advisory Board:-

"(1) Unopposed Motion.

That this Board desires to record its thanks to the Department
 that they have this year started to make a supplementary
 payment to teachers in cases where an incorrect cheque or
 no cheque has been issued at the correct time to the
 superintendent for them.

(2) Motions.

That this Board respectfully requests the Education
 Department to approach the Executive Committee of the
 Provincial Council to amend the regulations governing appoint-
 ments to this Board, so that the Native teachers and
 supervisors may be represented on this Board by one of
 their number or failing this by a European whom their
 teachers' association shall elect.

(3) That this Board respectfully requests that regulations
 be amended so that allowances shall not be deducted from the
 monthly salaries when the head teacher is sick and produces
 a doctor's certificate that he is unable to perform his
 school duties as a teacher for that first month of sickness.

(4) That in cases where two children alternate with one
 another as in farm schools classified D.B.F. by the
 Department, these children may be counted as one for
 the purpose of reckoning the total number of children who
 may be enrolled in that school in relation to the number
 of teachers etc.

(5) That this Board respectfully requests the
 Department to amend the school calendar, so that each term
 falls within its own quarter, and so that each term normally
 starts on a Tuesday and requests that each teacher may be
 supplied with one copy of this calendar at the beginning
 of the year.

(6) Notice of Question.

What is the salary paid by the Department to a male
 Native teacher who holds no teaching certificate and fails:-

- (a) in one subject in his N.P.H. final examination?
- (b) completely in this final examination?
